Washington—UPI—Congress went into an unofficial week long recess today as Republican members could return to their home states for a round of Lincoln Day speech-making.

The Senate and House were scheduled to hold skeleton sessions today and Thursday, but with the understanding that no business would be transacted while the GOP members were away.

The Lincoln Birthday recess is an annual concession to the Republicans. The Democrats traditionally take a week off later to stomp in birthday tributes to Andrew Jackson and Thomas Jefferson.

HITS CUBAN INFLUX

Miami—UPI—A ranking member of the House Armed Services Committee said Sunday night it would have been better for the Cuban refugees to have stayed in Cuba.

"They are not doing a bit of good in downtown Miami," said Rep. Walter Norblad (R-Ore.). He said the refugees could have carried out sabotage and intelligence activities against Fidel Castro's Communist regime had they stayed in Cuba.
