Museum Visited By 1,598 During Month of January

Some 1,598 persons visited Jacksonville museum during January, to top all previous Januarys except for 1959, according to the monthly report from the museum.

This brings to \$10,694, the number who have toured the museum since it was opened July 10, 1950. Visitors came from 29 states and three foreign countries—Canada, Mexico and China—during January.

Among the groups which toured the museum were the women of the Oregon Association of Painters and Contractors; Cub Scout Pack 60, Den 4 and Pack 44, Dens 1 and 5; Bluebirds and Angel Bluebirds, all of Medford, Bluebirds from Phoenix, and a group of Chinese students from Berkeley, Calif.

Gifts and Loans

During the month a number of gifts and loans have been made to the museum. They include books, fossil woods, minerals, carved ivory, pictures, clothing, stereoscopic view, magic lantern and slides, horsehoe, an 1840 bedspread, basket, doctor's kit, and photographs.

Among the items donated were a document appointing election judges for Big Butte precinct, 1880, and an advertising sheet published by the Jacksonville Times in 1881. They were donated by Tungsten Tucker, Prospect.
