Junior Engineer, Scientist Program Set at Corvallis

Corvallis - A summer training program for young engineers and scientists that started with 1 girl and 124 boys eight years ago at Oregon State university will be found across the U.S. this year.

Twelve Junior Engineers and Scientists Summer Institutes are planned in 11 states this summer with more than 1,500 youths from almost all states expected to participate. The Oregon State university JESSI this year is planned June 9 to 22, now for boys only, with a JESSI for girls from the Northwest slated June 16 to 29 at Willamette university.

Other states sponsoring the special programs this year will include Ohio, South Carolina, Colorado, Indiana, Texas, Pennsylvania, Michigan, New Mexico, Tennessee and Washington. Interested students from adjoining states will attend.

The institute provides an intensive two-week orientation in all fields of science and engineering for students entering their junior and senior years of high school. Classes are taught by university professors and students are divided into small groups to permit individual instruction and discussion.

Director of the program at OSU is Prof. Clyde M. Jensen, school of engineering. Sponsor of JESSI in cooperation with the various colleges, is Scientists of Tomorrow, a non-profit Portland corporation formed in 1955 to promote interest in science. Stanley Shirk is executive director.
