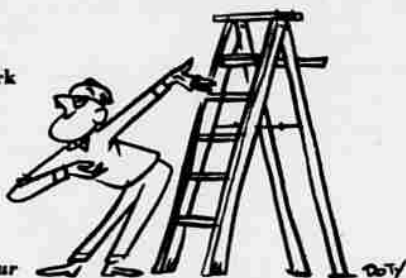


### Step Right Up

### Something Fishy

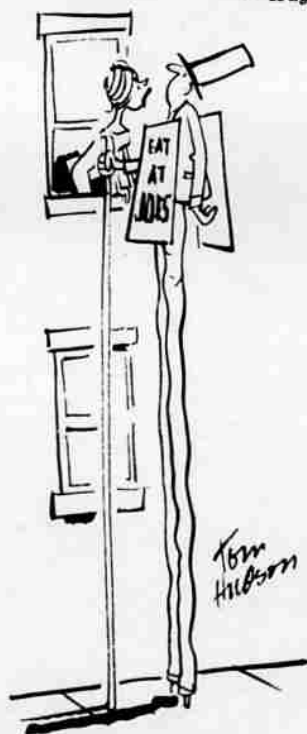
Fishy, fishy in the brook,
