It's a zestily seasoned relish, or salad if you prefer to serve it that way, made with canned Blue Lake green beans (a variety not a brand) and a small can of smoked oysters. Green onions, wine vinegar, salt and dried dill are deftly used. These green beans are Oregon and Washington grown.

Kraut-Stuffed Chops In a saucepan, combine one one-pound 11 ounce (No. 21) can sauerkraut, one cup chopped onion, one medium size apple, cored and chopped, and two tablespoons firmly packed brown sugar. Cook over medium heat until onions are tender and liquid has evaporated. Remove from heat and add one medium size potato, pared and grated. Meanwhile, sprinkle six medium-thick pork chops with salt and pepper. To stuff, place pork chops on counter, top with kraut mixture, another pork chop; repeat layers until all ingredients are used. Tie securely with heavy string and place in roasting pan, fat side up. Bake in moderate oven, 350 degrees, two hours and 15 minutes or until pork is done.

Dungeness Crab Superb Casserole Plentiful Dungeness crab reminds us of this exceptional quick and easy crab casserole for six praise-worthy servings. Thaw, if necessary, one pound crab meat and remove any shell or cartilage. Combine one half cup cooked peas, one can (10 1/2-ounce) condensed mushroom soup, dash of pepper. Add some white wine or lemon juice, if desired. We do.

Pickled Onion Rings Peel and cut four medium onions into one-fourth inch slices. Cover with water to which two tablespoons of salt are added. Let stand several hours. Simmer for about three minutes in the same salted water; drain; separate onion slices into rings. Blend 1 1/2 cups red wine vinegar, one-half cup water, two cups sugar and two teaspoons pickling spices; bring to boiling point. Pour hot vinegar mixture over onion rings. Let stand until cool. Serve as relish with beef or pork.
