Dream City Rises Off Florida Coast

Terra Verde, Fla. - 499 - A monument to a man and a dream is springing up here by the blue waters of the Gulf of Mexico off the sun-drenched west coast of Florida.
The man is Louis Berlant, a native of Connecticut who went to work as a laborer at the age of 14 and, 30 years later, had become head of one of the largest construction empires in the world.
His dream was to build a community that would give its population and visitors the daily pleasures of a year-round resort and yet be near a major center offering employment and growth potential.
The monument to the island of Terra Verde is the island city of Terra Verde, Spaniard for "Green Earth".
Several years of searching across the United States and into South America and Europe elapsed before Berlant was to find the ideal location for his pioneering project.
"it turned out that the keys off St. Petersburg were really the only perfect spot for the undertaking," he said as Terra Verde's recent official opening.
In association with his son Fred, and with the financial backing of the famous Murchison brother of Dallas, Texas, John D. and Clint W. Jr., Berlant has made a planned city.

Business Peace Corps Suggested By Professor
East Lansing, Mich. - 498 - The Peace Corps, considered by many one of the most successful people-people efforts undertaken by the U.S. government, should be expanded into business enterprises, according to a Michigan State University professor.
Dr. Mordechai Kreinin, economics professor, suggests that the Peace Corps move into cooperation with small and medium sized business firms abroad.
"The success of the Peace Corps brings to mind the possibility of enlisting business organizations in similar pursuits in the area of technical assistance," Kreinin said.
He suggested such a program could be administered by the Agency for International Development (AID) or an independent agency.
"Under the plan a participating American enterprise would form a partnership with either private interests or the government of an underdeveloped country, with the foreign partner always in charge of the controlling share," Kreinin said.
"The American partner would supply the central core of managerial and technical personnel necessary to set up a plant in the participating country. The American partner would gradually take over the management."
Kreinin's plan called for the cooperative contracts to specify a date for terminating the partnership, at which time the American partner would pull out, leaving behind a viable indigenous company.
Giant enterprises should be excluded from such a program, the MSU professor said, because the program would have to overcome the reluctance of American businessmen to enter into partnerships with foreign governments and the possible fears of controlling the part of the participating foreign country.
