Wife Held After Portland Man Shot

Portland — (UPI) — Robert Cameron Smith, 39, Portland, was in critical condition today after being wounded in the chest with a .45 caliber automatic Sunday night.

Police held his estranged wife, Mrs. Anita L. Smith, 37, on a charge of assault with intent to kill. Bail was set at \$10,000.

French Riot Police To Mining Towns

Paris — (UPI) — President Charles de Gaulle today moved steel-helmeted riot police into northwestern mining towns in a showdown with defiant striking miners.

Union leaders rejected a government order of "work or face the consequences." An estimated 200,000 coal miners have been striking since Friday for higher pay. They were backed by more than 500,000 workers in other nationalized industries, most of whom planned sympathy walkouts Tuesday.

Truckloads of armed gendarmes late Sunday began rolling into the towns of Saint Amand, Merlebach, Forbach, Striding-Wend, and Hier.

Labor leaders said the government's threat of arrest and possible jail or fines for strikers have made things worse. They called a mass meeting of 100,000 miners for today at Lens.

Man Tells Police He Is Not Dead

Portland — (UPI) — A former Walla Walla, Wash., man walked into the Portland Police Bureau here Saturday to declare he was not either dead.

William Bernard Kortum, 55, now living in Portland, said his wife, Alma, of Walla Walla, reported him missing last October, and later identified him in Phillipsburg, Mont., as the victim of a shooting.

Police believed his story and notified Montana authorities. But Kortum had to post \$10 bond before he was allowed to leave. While he was explaining, officers dug up a Portland city warrant charging him with jaywalking.

Peru Calm After Bloodless Coup

Lima, Peru — (UPI) — Peru was calm today following a bloodless coup by the armed forces that ousted military junta President Ricardo Perez Godoy as a would-be dictator.

The coup Sunday morning was led by Perez Godoy's three junta colleagues, who renewed the junta pledge to return the nation to civilian rule after presidential elections in June.

Gen. Nicolas Lindley Lopez, 54, an outspoken anti-Communist regarded as a friend of the United States, took over as new junta president under the law of succession established by the junta when it assumed power last June.

Perez Godoy remained at his home in suburban Miraflores Sunday night, apparently under house arrest. He
