

Castro Decrees Death for Thieves

Miami (UPI)—Premier Fidel Castro decreed death early today for burglars, false policemen and thieves who use children in their work.

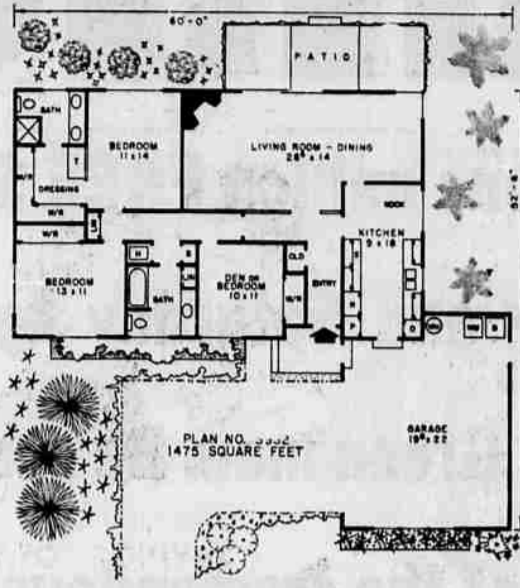
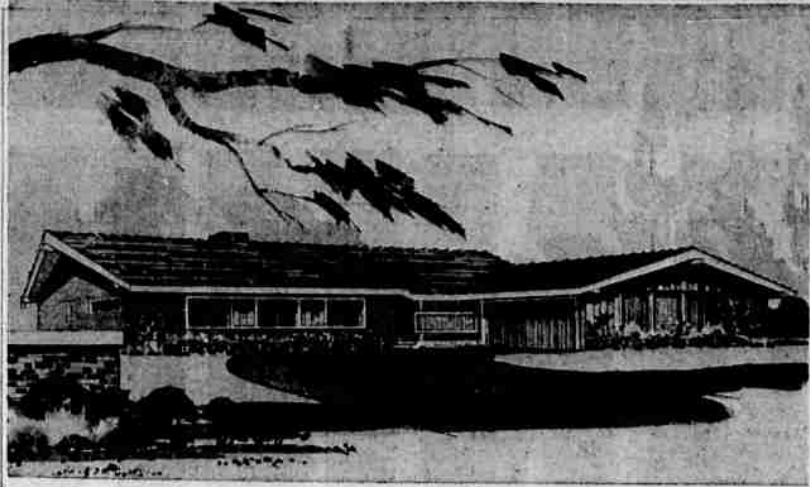
In a two-hour speech broadcast by Radio Havana, Castro declared also that he has just patched up his differences with the Roman Catholic church. He said some fundamentalist Protestant sects still oppose him, but charged that they are "subsidized by U. S. imperialists."

The bearded revolutionary depicted Havana as a city terrorized in some areas by housebreakers and infested in others by "pretty boys," "students who do not study," and "bums" and "shiftless types" who hang around pool halls. It was the first time he had revealed the existence of 30 many "antisocial types" in Cuba.

Castro said he is going to recruit troops and skilled workmen from factories to man the "most modern weapons" which he said his regime now possesses.

He denounced refugees for fleeing from Cuba, but at the same time assailed the United States for not providing transportation to carry them away.

This was a reference to the fact that the most recent sea shipment of U. S. ransom goods to the Castro regime was carried by a freighter which went on to Germany instead of returning to the United States.



This Week's Plan for Home Builders

A house of true quality reflects attention to detail. Here is such a house.

This home is simple in concept and very economical to build. The exterior design of most rectangular homes leaves considerable to be desired. This is definitely not true with this home. The windows in the front bedrooms and bath have all been tied together with a wooden frame which projects past the wall of the house. This adds immeasurably to the refreshing exterior and makes it impossible to spot the bath location from the street. Wide expanses of stone veneer flank the bank of windows while a low stone planter complements the overall design.

The handsome front wall of

the garage consists of three stationary obscure windows plus stone veneer and planter. Beams project from the top and ends of each roof gable. Especially notice how the roof has been extended over the front porch so that the eaves of the house meet those of the garage. This roof is supported by posts to which has been attached a screen that enhances the overall beauty of the home and also provides privacy at the front entry.

There is easy traffic circulation to all areas without undesirable room-crossing. A partial wall separates the entry from the living room. This visually expands both areas and allows light from the living room to reach the entry.

Despite the size of the house, the master bedroom enjoys the luxury of a private dressing room and bath. Besides an unusual amount of wardrobe space, the dressing room has a wide dressing table. The bath features a semi-hidden water closet and a twin pullman lavatory.

Imaginative planning has created a family bath with a long pullman lavatory, a linen closet, an enclosed tub with shower over and a recessed water closet. The spacious living-dining room has been made to appear even larger by using wide sliding glass doors which open to the rear patio.

In addition to the usual built-ins, this kitchen offers a wide pantry plus a generous size eating nook.

Stop Signs Are Installed in City

Stop signs were installed yesterday at three intersections and a yield sign at a fourth intersection, Vernon Thorpe, city engineer said.

The signs were recommended by the city's traffic coordinating committee, according to Robert A. Duff, city manager.

The stop signs will be at Niantic and Edwards sts. to stop Niantic st. traffic; Edwards and Boardman sts., to stop Boardman st. traffic; and Capital ave. and Valley View dr. to stop eastbound traffic on Capital ave.

The yield sign is located at the intersection of Highland dr., Keenway dr., and Barneburg rd. Traffic on both Keenway dr. and Barneburg rd. will yield to Highland dr. traffic, Thorpe said. He said this intersection is the fourth location in the city where a yield sign is located.

A full stop is not necessary for a yield sign, it was noted, but traffic at the intersection must yield to traffic on both the left and right.

Elderly Man Dies In Lake Grove Fire

Lake Oswego, Ore. (UPI)—An elderly man died Wednesday when fire swept through a two-story home at Lake Grove near here.
