165 Million Board Feet Timber Sold

Portland in western Oregon the bureau of land management has sold 165,000,000 board feet of storm damaged timber and has an additional 514,000,000 board feet ready for sale, a BLM official told the Portland Transportation club recently.

R. O. Fety, chief, branch of BLM forest operations in Oregon and Washington, said that 52 per cent of the recoverable salvage timber on BLM lands resulting from the Oct. 12 windstorm will be offered for sale before next June 30. Thirty-eight per cent will be offered during the first half of the next fiscal year, and the remaining 10 per cent, most of which will be offered in subsequent periods.

The gross damage on the BLM administered O&C forest following the storm last Columbus Day has been estimated at 1.5 billion board feet. BLM figures that about 1.3 billion board feet of that can be salvaged.

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Man Found Dead In Steam Bath

Portland - (UPI) - A man found dead in a steam bath here March 6 has been identified as Eino Severus Haapana, 72, police said today.

Death was from natural causes, police said. The victim was made by fingerprints, and that Haapana was a former captain of the Port of New York who moved to Portland in 1942.
