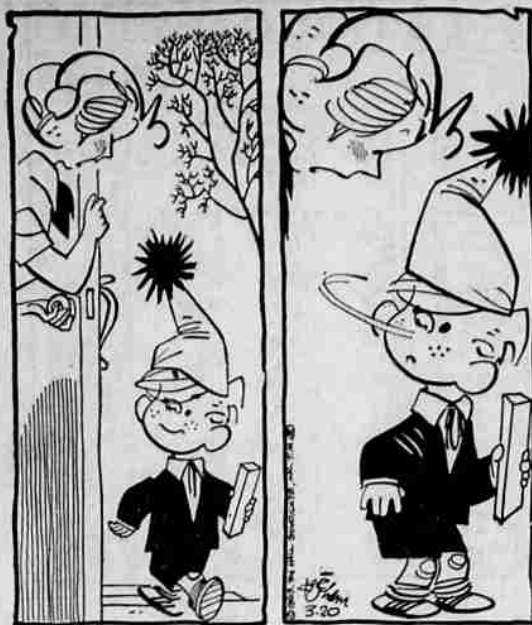

Good Colors Used In Home Planning

Gone are the days of dull bedroom furnishings. Today's fashions for bedrooms are just as exciting as Paris fashions. Yet, so often homemakers concentrate all of their budget on the living rooms and use "leftovers" to achieve a rather haphazard effect in the bedrooms. Domestic fabrics inspired by the beautiful Indian saris are interpreted in cotton border designs, intricate paisley prints that once adorned sari bandings, and through the subtle use of metallic yarns. From Indonesia... artistic rendering of hand-blocked batik and semi-geometrical motifs are used in intricate arrangements; from the Orient come medallions and exotic flat prints.

Polka dots of all sizes have returned to fashion. Classic dots from aspirin size to silver dollar sizes; extreme circles; bull's-eye patterns; blotch effects and overlapping abstract types are all noted.

Two-Button Men's Suits Are Trend

Spring, 1963, will mark an important point of departure from styles of recent years in many key segments of a man's wardrobe.

Most notable, are the strong trends to the two-button model and to brighter-than-medium tones in men's suits. Light, silvery greys are a top style favorite.

Next most newsworthy development is the introduction of "suiling weight" fabrics in the new spring topcoats.

Stripes, ranging from the big broad and bold to pin stripes take on a new importance in men's shirts, both dress and sports.

Sportswear gives new emphasis to co-ordination, with sports jackets, slacks and walk shorts literally "made for one another."

Fashion to flatter is the softly-shaped coat with lightly indented front and smooth, gently eased or cape-full back.

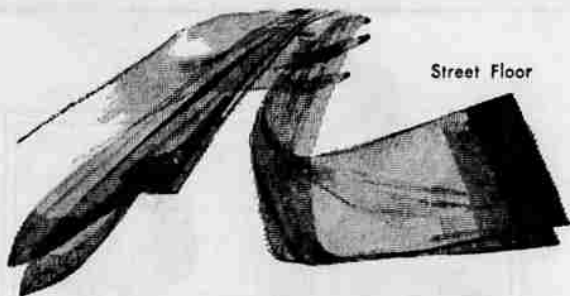

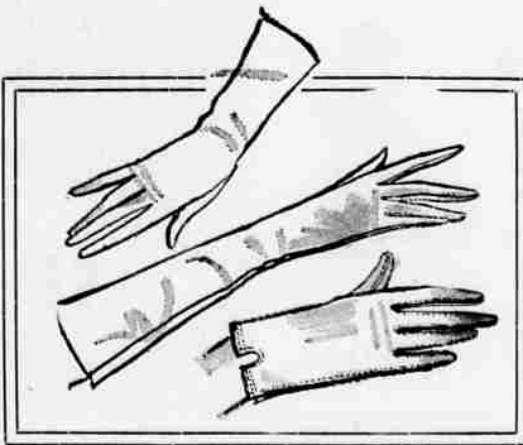
