Wendt Resigns as Principal in GP

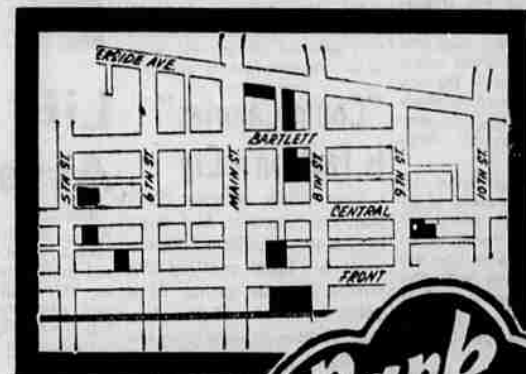
Grants Pass — Robert C. Wendt, principal of the Highland elementary school here, has announced his resignation effective at the end of the current school year.

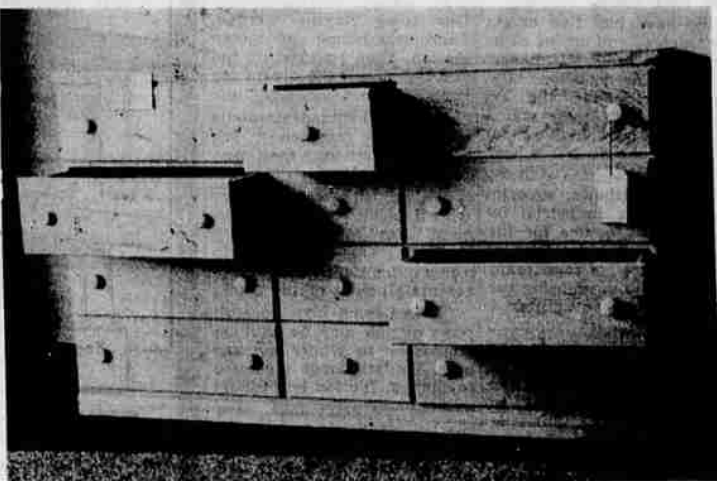

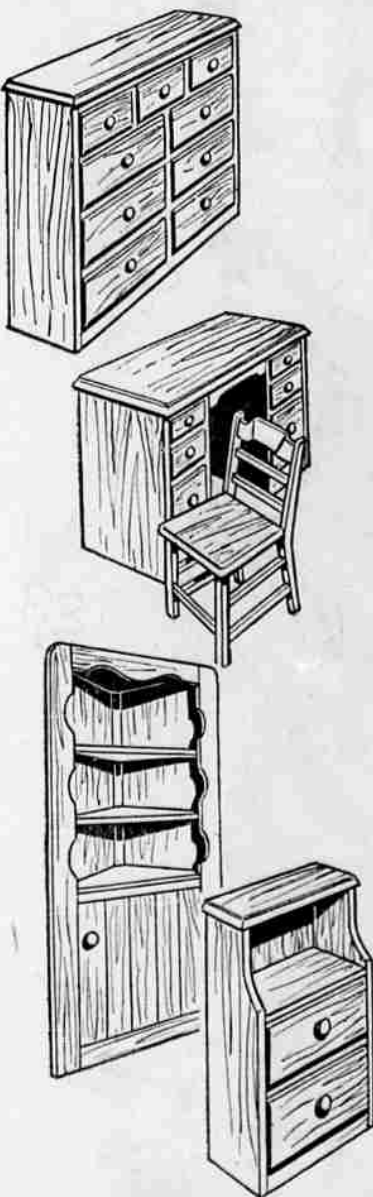
