Next news note is the "look of more collar." A bit higher, a mile fuller in the cape, and a little wider in the spread, these styles have a dressier look without sacrificing summer comfort.

Low Band

Tables Expand For Seating at Dinner

You needn't be thwarted from entertaining on a grand scale this Easter, by the lack of an adequate dining table.

In the home or apartment where dining and living are combined in one area, the problem of how to entertain a large dining group can be acute.

Modern ingenuity in furniture design has the answer in tables that take up little space when not in use. Their expandable mechanism is no more complicated than the familiar card table or add-a-leaf dining table.

Tables that hide inside of cabinets, masquerade as consoles, or fold into about a foot of space are decorative and useful every day of the year.

Early American, French Provincial, Modern or Traditional styles are available to match or contrast with other furnishings. Between parties these concealed tables take their place gracefully in entrance hall, living room, or as a server in the dining area. Cabinets or consoles which open into tables accommodating at least twelve chairs or an endless number of buffet guests make even small quarters hospitably spacious.

Kings Named
Formal styles usually have the name of a king, queen or famous furniture designer such as Louis XV or Louis XVI or Queen Anne. Informal styles often are associated with a country: Early American, Danish Modern, French Provincial, Rural English, etc.

Teakwoods, whitens and golds, honey-gold walnuts, pecan and primavera woods, elegant mahogonies as well as traditional pines, cherries and maples are shown on all types of furniture this season.

Tall Cabinets
Tall cabinets, called "what-nots" in great grandmothers' day, are having a modern revival in new forms. These are not just for the display of odds and ends and what have you, but to serve a functional purpose, attractively.

Chairs matched in styling, often called "Mr. and Mrs." chairs are a wise investment for most homes. The man's chair is usually a little higher and wider than the woman's, but to balance the scale here usually has a matching ottoman.

Sofa beds, sleep lounges and studio couches are tops on the nation's best-seller list. They are smartly styled, comfortable and are a perfect solution to space problems.

Table Setting at Easter Simple If Rules Summed Up

How to set the table for Easter feasting and other particular occasions is often a question that sends both new and seasoned hostesses scurrying to etiquette books for the answer. According to the Dew City Industry Council, the rules are simple and may be summed up briefly.

Family dinner—At a family dinner, silver and china are on the table for the menu which usually includes soup, a main dish, salad and bread and butter. Dessert plates and spoons and forks come to the table later.

Formal dinner—At a formal dinner, the service plate is the only china on the table at the beginning. All forks except the oyster fork go at the left of the plate, in the order in which they are to be used, from the outside in. Knives and spoons go at the right.

Coffee Service
Informal luncheon: The bread and butter plates are on the table, indicating that the meal is informal. The silver on the table includes a soup spoon, knife, fork and salad fork. The coffee service is on the table, and dessert plates and knives and forks will be brought to the table later.

Buffet service—The china and silver for the main course are conveniently laid out, for the guests help themselves here. Another table holds the coffee service.

Tea service—Usually a delicate and light china is used in keeping with the dainty type of food served. A sugar spoon and lemon fork should be part of the tea service. Both cream and lemon should be available.
