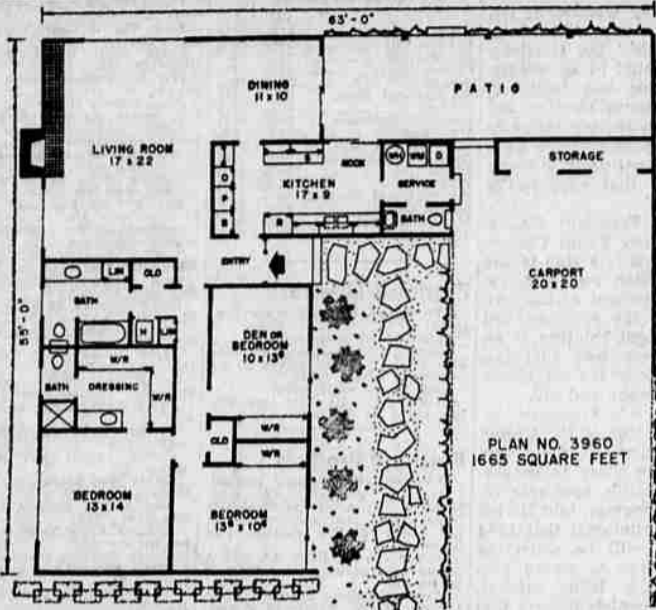


# This Week's Plan for Home Builders

If you have a flair for the unconventional and think in terms of today and not yesterday, contemporary lines of this modern, luxurious looking home must certainly meet with your approval.

The exterior of the house is both attractive and sensibly planned for modern living. The long, low lines of the roof help the house look much larger than it actually is. Stone veneer is a pleasing contrast to the vertical siding and painted trim.

The wide wooden fascia at the top of the roof is duplicated near the floor level with a tone veneer below. An open beam roof extends from the house out to the edge of the driveway and is supported by a series of posts.

**Obtain Privacy**  
To obtain privacy, the entry was located some distance from the street. Neither the entry or any windows in the same face the street.

From the well lighted entry, there is direct access to the kitchen, bedroom wing or living area.

Four large closets open to

the short hall which leads to all bedrooms. All bedrooms have an exceptional amount of wardrobe space and will accommodate twin beds. The elegant design of the master bedroom suite with its private dressing room and bath allows much more wall space for furniture arrangement in the bedroom.

**Pullman Lavatory**  
The family bath has a pullman lavatory—as does the private bath—a linen closet and an enclosed tub with shower over. The third bath is conveniently located near the service where it is easily reached from both the kitchen and the outside of the house.

The outstanding feature of this plan is the generous size of the handsome living room with its modern fireplace and long hearth. The dining area is open to the living room but it is of sufficient size to be completely separated from the living room with a wall

if a private dining room is preferred. The illusion of size in this room is further enhanced by the wide sliding glass doors which open to the roofed patio.

The kitchen is a model of efficiency with all doors located so as to provide a maximum amount of wall space. Besides a roomy pantry, note the nook area and the sliding doors opening to the patio. There is no doubt that the patio will serve as an outside dining and family room.

A huge storage closet forms the back wall of the carport.

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## Censorship Group In Las Vegas Bans Book, Magazines

Las Vegas, Nev. — It's "in" to go to a nude show in Las Vegas but it's "out" to look at a nudist magazine or read "Tropic of Cancer."

That's the word from the police department and a steering committee on censorship which today ordered 200 magazine dealers to clear their racks of six magazines judged by the committee to be pornographic.

Henry Miller's "Tropic of Cancer," sold here at news stands in a paperback edition, also was banned.

City Atty. Sidney Whitmore, chairman of the newly-created censorship group, said the action was taken due to "a growing public interest" in the distribution of "girlie" magazines here.

Uniformed police officers delivered a written order to each of the dealers today and department spokesmen said that if the magazines and the novel were not removed from the stands violators would be cited under a city ordinance which bans the sale of obscene material.

**Magazines Named**  
The magazines termed pornographic by the committee were "Sundial," "Nude Living," "Satana," "Nylon Jungle," "Playgirl" and "World of Men."

The steering committee—made up of two men and five women—was selected by Whitmore on the basis of "their interest in clearing up the problem."

A similar committee was formed here two years ago but dissolved without ridding the stands of any of what it termed objectionable material.

Bare-breasted floor shows are featured at two of the "Strip" hotels, at present. At various times during the year, however, there are as many as four. In order to attend any of the nude performances, one must be at least 21-years-old.

The Parent-Teachers association here holds that teen-

agers, however, are buying the nude magazines even though signs are posted in most shops warning that minors are not allowed to purchase items.

Whitmore said his committee of seven will meet once a week to consider passing judgement on additional magazines it feels may be termed obscene.

Most dealers refused comment on the order.

One, who asked that his name not be used, voiced an objection:

"They pick out five or six magazines and outlaw them, but there must be 100 more on the market. Some of the ones they think are okay have the same pictures in them that the banned ones do."

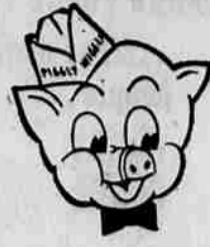
