Yturri Admitted To UO Hospital

Portland - UPI - State Sen. Anthony Yturri (R-Ore.) was admitted to the University of Oregon Medical School hospital Sunday.

Yturri, 48-year-old Senate minority leader, was reported in satisfactory condition. There was no immediate word on his ailment.

On March 8 Yturri complained of feeling weak while standing in a Capitol building hallway in Salem and was hospitalized. He was back at his desk about three days later.

Doctors said he had not suffered a heart ailment but was just tired.

Hatfield Returns To Desk at Salem

Salem - UPI - Gov. Mark Hatfield was back at work here today following a five-day visit to New York and Kentucky.

Hatfield arrived in Portland by plane Sunday night. He was in New York in an attempt to recruit new industry for Oregon and attended Saturday night's Oregon State basketball game against Duke in the NCAA championship basketball tournament at Louisville.

He had breakfast with New York Gov. Nelson Rockefeller Friday.

Hatfield scheduled a news conference at 3:30 p.m. today.

Vern Voss Named Outstanding Teacher

Vern Voss, Medford High school wood shop instructor, was selected the state's outstanding industrial arts teacher of the year at the spring banquet of the Oregon Industrial Arts Association during the OEA Convention in Portland last week.

This is the first time an outstanding industrial arts instructor has been selected, and Voss will be honored at the national convention in Indianapolis, Ind., in April.

The selection was made by a committee composed of Dr. Leon Minear, state superintendent of public instruction; Jim O'Gara, Portland industrial arts supervisor; and Dr. Chester Ainsworth, Oregon State university.

Voss has taught in the Medford system since Jan. 13, 1946, being at junior high schools until he was transferred to Medford High school in 1960. He is the immediate past president of the Oregon Industrial Arts Association, having also served as vice president and executive board member for three years.

Hoffa's Union To Spend \$4 Million

Miami, Fla., UPI - Teamsters Union President James Hoffa said Sunday night he is preparing to spend \$4 million in union funds on a tract of Dade county, Fla., land.

Hoffa declined to discuss details of the transaction, but did say it would be completed "this week." He said the money would come from the union's pension fund.

Hoffa said the deal was not yet complete and therefore he could not elaborate.
