In early 1863 the Civil War swept over the lush plantations of Louisiana across the Mississippi River from the Confederate stronghold of Vicksburg.

Only Vicksburg, Miss., and Port Hudson, La., both on the east bank of the river, stood between success and defeat for that part of the embattled Confederacy.

The classic pattern of war—professionals fighting professionals with the populace largely undisturbed—was going out of style. Now the war was coming home to the plantation mansions with their gracious living.

Union generals were learning to subsist their armies on the country, eating what they could on the spot, carrying away hordes of food and destroying the rest.

"I think I will never see lilac blooms again without recalling this sad incident." Six days later Kate went through a different sort of experience, this time at the hands of fractious slaves.
