Long Beach, Calif. — (UPI) — Mrs. Mary Ferguson was ecstatic today because her measurements were only 49-42-53 1/2.

"I've lost 14 pounds and four inches in every direction," was the happy report of the 5-foot-2 woman who weighed 244 pounds and measured 52-46-59 when she began a two-week diet on March 17.

Mrs. Ferguson had hoped to lose 50 pounds so she can fit into new Easter clothes, but her doctor had told her it was "pretty impossible."

"About two pounds a day is the most I can expect," she said. "When I get home I'm going to work real hard and get down to 128. It may take a year."
