14 Measles Cases Reported in County

All cases of measles in Jackson county during last week were in Medford and Ashland, according to the Jackson county health department.

Medford had 10 cases and Ashland 4. There were 4 cases of German measles in Medford.

There were 17 cases of influenza in the county. Seven were in Medford, 7 in Ashland and 3 in Jacksonville.

Other communicable diseases reported to the department were infectious hepatitis, Medford 2, Central Point 2; scarlet fever, Medford 2; tuberculosis, Medford 1; pneumonia, Ashland 2.
