School Fund Law Repeal Approved

Salem—UPI—Repeal of the county school fund law which now operates as a property tax offset has been approved 6-2 by the House Tax committee.

In practice, the measure affects only Multnomah county. Under the proposed bill, state aid would go to the school districts rather than as offsets in the county budget.

The committee also: —Gave a do pass recommendation to a Senate-passed bill which would exempt people's utility districts from the corporate excise tax.

—Approved a measure which would require availability and cost of using roads to be considered in determining the true cash value of timber lands for property tax purposes.
