Boxing Ring Death, Violence, Featured in State's News

The ring death of former featherweight champion Davey Moore in Los Angeles saddened persons who have never seen a fight and outraged anti-boxing forces championed by Gov. Edmund G. Brown.

At the same time, middle of the road opinion on the subject was speaking out.
One assemblyman, George A. Milias (R-Gilroy), said he was "not convinced that complete outlawing of the sport is the answer."

Moore's death came four days after a 10-round bout with Sugar Ramos following a coma, induced by a "massive" brain injury, from which he never awoke.

Although medical opinion is holding Moore died not from a blow by Ramos, but from a "million to one" brush with the ropes around the ring, legislative wheels began turning to abolish the sport.
If, as Gov. Brown said in a special press conference he called the same day Moore died, "... if it can be called a sport..."

Whether the controversy would rage long enough to retain the attention of a busy legislature, and whether anti-boxing advocates gained sufficient strength with Moore's death, to make a fight of it when the day came, remained to be seen.

Moore's death by brain injury was blamed by neurosurgeons on a ring - stand which his head fell against. A review of fight films showed the lower rope vibrated at the back of his head, apparently at the base of the skull. Death was caused by "massive bruises" in the brain area.

Explosion: A violent explosion in the basement of the J. C. Penney department store in San Jose resulted in the deaths of four persons and injured 70 others. An ex-janitor, Ricardo Mello, 27, fired only hours before the blast, was charged with voluntary manslaughter - although District Attorney Louis Berona said he believed Mello did not intend to kill anyone when he neglected to close a blower of the boiler.

Certificates: The Federal Reserve bank in San Francisco reported it apparently destroyed by accident \$7.3 million in negotiable treasury certificates last summer. The bank called it a "million to one" error.

one" error. "We have completely eliminated the theory that the certificates have been stolen," Eliot J. Swan, bank president, said. He said he believed they were burned following a transfer of envelopes in which they were stored in double-security vaults.

Cancer Doesn't Always Kill
Can cancer keep threatening a person for 21 years? Mrs. Joan Linstead answers "Yes" in her book, My 21 Years With Cancer (Exposition Press), which tells of her long years of fighting cancer in herself. I - my half-century in medicine.

the last I saw of her, two years later, she still was well. Another patient of mine, after having a breast removed for cancer, remained well for some 15 years. What then surprised me was that the old cancer showed up in the scar of the wound on her chest wall. This suggested that cancer cells had been left behind there at the time of the operation, but had not grown until perhaps, when the woman became old and weakened, she lost her strong resistance to the disease.

Mrs. Linstead tells in her book about her two trips to see a once notorious cancer quack who has now been put out of business by the health authorities of the United States.

As so often happens, although this man probably took her money in advance and then certainly did not help her, she has no harsh word to say about him. This strong tendency of people to love a quack even after he has gyped them is what keeps the man in business.

Worth's Quack's Fee
As Mrs. Linstead says, as a person with an inoperable cancer feels that it was worth the quack's fee to get some hope for a few months and hence better sleep at night.

Many years ago I learned much when I read the annual report of the Middlesex Hospital in England, dated around 1895. In those days they didn't perform the operations which today our surgeons practically always perform on the woman who has cancer of the breast. In 1895, they just gave the woman nursing care. What impressed me tremendously was that, as I remember, 10 per cent of the women, without any effort at treatment of the cancer, lived on for five years, and some 5 per cent just didn't die of the cancer. They lived for years until a heart attack or a pneumonia carried them off.

Cancer Revealed
Many times in my life I have seen people with cancer who lived in good health for many years. For instance, there was the school teacher who had her breast removed for cancer. Fourteen years later she happened to bump her hip going through a door, and when it went hurting, she came to me. When I X-rayed the hip, I was surprised to see the bone full of cancer which had probably been there for the 14 years. Evidently, the bad cells had not been able to grow. I had a roentgenologist give her some X-ray treatments, and
