IT'S YOUR LAW

Respect for Law Makes Democracy Live

CONTRACT RIGHTS

A contract is a promise which the law will enforce. Most adults have, at some time, entered into agreements which constitute legally binding contracts. Such an exchange of promises, each of which confers some benefit on the other party, gives rise to certain rights in both persons. Those rights become the object of attention when one party fails to carry out his promise.

What can be done when one party to a binding contract fails or refuses to perform? First, and most common, is a court action for money damages. Such damages are generally measured by the loss sustained by the not grant the remedy of aggrieved person. The law will attempt to put the wronged party in the position he would have occupied had the contract been carried out. Sometimes money damages will not put the wronged party in the position he would have occupied had the contract been carried out. Thus, where someone agrees to sell his house to you and then refuses to transfer the property, you can sue for "specific performance" and the court may compel the transfer of the property.

However, there are situations in which the law will

money damages nor specific performance, as for example in a case where the performance is impossible on a ground which the law finds excusable, such as the outbreak of war. Relief may be denied in some cases on the ground of public policy, as where the subject of the contract is illegal, such as in wagering cases the courts will refuse to grant relief.
