Commemorative Stamp Available

Another five-cent stamp in the commemorative series goes on sale Monday at the main post office in Medford, at Central Point, and at Station 1 and the Village Variety branches in Medford.

It is the Carolina Charter stamp. The design is based on a photograph of the first page of the charter against a background of red velvet.

The lettering on the stamp is in tones of deep brown similar to that of the original charter which is now in the Hall of History in Raleigh, N.C. The charter was a link for the colonies to such basic human rights documents as the Magna Carta, the post office department has noted in describing the new commemorative.

Life Underwriters Holding Classes For Area Agents

Part I of the Life Underwriter Training Council class is nearing completion, according to Bill Brooks, 1649 Grand ave., chairman of Life Insurance Week in the Rogue valley.

The LUTC course consists of 24 3 1/2-hour classes. Students attend one class a week from October until May. Purpose is to give the underwriter more knowledge of the way life insurance works and how it can provide money for specific purposes.

Part II deals with life insurance for business organizations, group insurance, and program planning. Both parts must be completed before a diploma can be presented.

First Class in Area

This is the first class which has been conducted in the valley in several years, Brooks explained. Another class is planned for next October. Persons interested in attending should contact any member of the Rogue valley association. Local classes are held at the Rogue Valley Country club on Mondays.

The course is sponsored by the National Association of Life Underwriters, the local chapter, Rogue Valley Association of Life Underwriters. It is not necessary for an agent to be an association member to attend, Brooks added.

Six classes of seniors, students of the American Problems, Medford High school classes, attended a recent session.

Underwriters on the team were Fred Sears, Wayne King, Don Carlson, Gene Williams, Clarence Schmidt, Jim Quinn, Art Savard, I. R. Perry and Brooks as chairman.
