Jacksonville Music Festival Is Reviewed at Roundtable

"Up to three weeks ago, we were hoping for, planning for, a music festival in Jacksonville," Sam D. McKinney said Monday. "Now, we can definitely say there will be one this summer on the Peter Britt estate."

McKinney, general manager of the Peter Britt Garden Music and Art Festival association, addressed the luncheon meeting of the Chamber of Commerce Roundtable to discuss the group's plans for assembling a "first-class symphony orchestra" in Jacksonville for 21 days during the late summer.

The speaker is currently manager of Skidmore House in Portland and was for four years promotion manager for the Lloyd Center there.

asked that each person pledge \$10 in support of the music festival. "We need to have about \$9,400 raised in advance for the festival," he said, adding that about \$3,400 had already been pledged.

Further, the speaker said he wanted 35 firms in the area to agree to take 20 tickets each for the festival. "We want their checks now for the tickets," he said, "and they can easily resell the tickets later."

He explained that he and John Trudeau, conductor of the Portland Pops orchestra, had for some years been looking for a location in Oregon to establish a music festival somewhat on the order of established festivals at Carmel, Calif., and Aspen, Colo.
