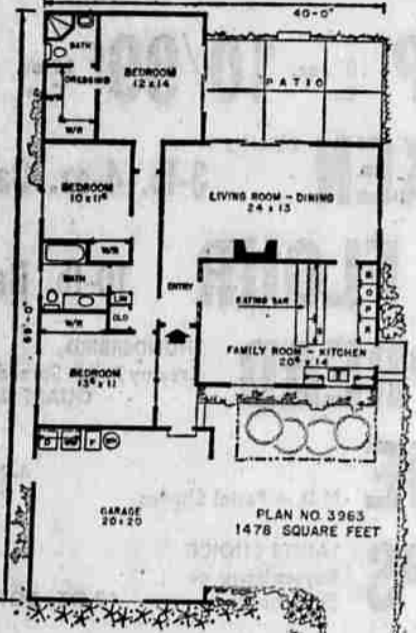
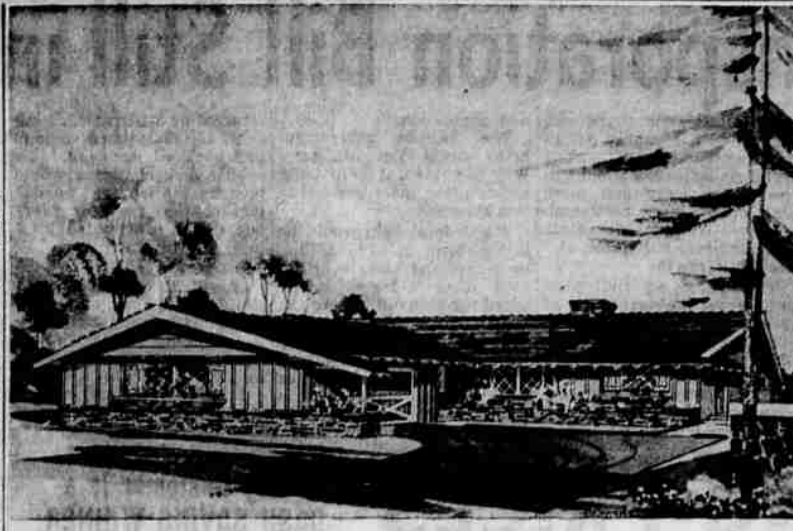
Members voted to continue the meetings on the second and fourth Fridays of each month.

**This Week's Plan for Home Builders**

One of the most difficult assignments is to design a well planned home which incorporates a majority of today's most desired features and which can be built on a 50 foot lot. Here is a plan which meets these requirements.

A roofed porch provides a protected passageway from

the garage to the front door. Traffic is channeled from the entry to every area of the house. A partial wall with turned posts above separate the entry from the family room.

Open planning can double your living areas both visually and physically. Open planning will give your family a freedom of movement and the much sought after sense of spaciousness. This is why only cabinets have been used to separate the generous size family room and kitchen. Family meals can be informally served at the long eating bar. All cabinets and appliances which would obstruct the view-broom and pantry closets, oven and refrigerator - are located along one wall. The family room serves many purposes. It can be used as a rainy day play area, a room for the pursuit of hobbies or as a television room.

**Large Room**  
One of the outstanding features of this home is the huge living room and dining area. Instead of forming the usual dining ell, we have maintained the same room width throughout. A wide fireplace faces the sliding glass doors to the private patio. Similar doors open from the master bedroom and let in the ever-changing outdoors and sunshine. A shoulder high window has been placed in the end wall next to the dining area.

Wardrobes with drawers below and the usual pole and shelf above serve all bedrooms. Two of these rooms will accommodate twin beds. The luxurious master bedroom suite has a private dressing area and bath.

The wood roofing, used brick veneer and planters,

wood double hung windows and the wood siding all complement each other.

Most garages located at the front of the home are eyesores rather than eye-catchers. This garage definitely belongs to the latter group. A tapered barge board outlines the gable of the garage where horizontal siding visually decreases the garage height. The gable wall projects past the wall of the garage. The low sweeping garage roof lines have been achieved by extending a portion of the roof over a planter at the side of the garage.
