Sorting Excess Baggage From Old Constitution Major Task

Editor's note: The House decides Monday whether it wants the people to vote next May on a new constitution. This is the fifth in a series of six articles.

Salem — (UPI) — A constitution that develops over 106 years picks up a lot of excess baggage. It also acquires some traditions, and a unique flavor of its own.

The new document strengthens such rights as those of an accused person to counsel, protection against double jeopardy, and compensation in condemnation cases.

The House committee voted to keep the death penalty for first degree murder, but a jury would have to recommend it. It now is automatic unless a jury recommends against it. The Senate committee so far has agreed with the commission that the whole issue should be moved to the laws. The House committee felt the question should be submitted to voters separately, so that a new constitution might not stand or fall on that issue.
