Portland — UPB — Three civil suits have been filed in Circuit Court here claiming no return on land investments in Central Oregon.

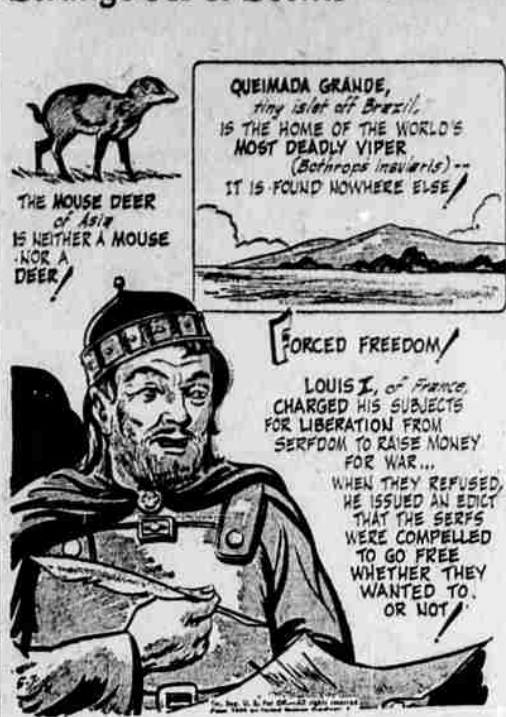
The suits were filed by Paul C. Davenport, Robert and Patty Detrick, and Richard and Mary Gainer.

Davenport filed suit against Charles M. Simmons asking return of some \$4,000 invested in land near La Pine and also \$20,000 in punitive damages.

The Detricks filed suit against Simmons, La Pine Corp., Trans-American Property Corp., Charles Simmons II and Francis J. Roy, asserting they invested some \$15,000 and had not yet received land deeds.

Measures Voted By Legislature

Salem — UPB — Measures approved Monday by the legislature: HB1182 — New constitution; HB1306 — Unauthorized use of personal property; HB1590 — Nonvoting electors; HB1818 — Measures submitted to people; SCR12 — Sorrow at death of Joseph E. Dunne; SB114 — Personal income taxation; SB161 — Civil court proceedings by cities and charter counties; SB171 — County surveyors; SB193 — Witnesses to wills; SB194 — Relating to wills; SB216 — Dog license fund; SB220 — Service and summons; SB282 — Duties of clerks in charter counties; SB343 — Well drilling; SB392 — White Birch cemetery; SB412 — Repayment for certain storm-caused repairs.

Log Export Bill Sent To Governor

Salem — UPB — A bill to permit export of certain raw logs cut from state or county lands went to the governor Monday. The House agreed to accept Senate amendments. The bill would amend a 1961 law requiring primary manufacture of such logs in Oregon. It would give an outright exemption to Port Orford white cedar. Backers said there is no demand for manufacture of raw cedar logs at Oregon mills. The measure provides for an export permit system, under the Forestry department, for other logs. Export of raw logs would be permitted only when a surplus over the needs of Oregon mills was shown.

Terry Green Named To Director Post

Terry D. Green, Medford, was elected one of four national directors of the Junior Chamber of Commerce at the annual convention of the Oregon State Jaycees in Portland Saturday. Keith Krambeal, Eagle Point, was elected one of 12 state vice presidents, who make up the governing body of the Jaycees. He represents district 9. Another southern Oregon member, Gordon Burn, Grants Pass, was elected to the post of international director. Frank Branner, 29, of Portland, was elected president of the organization for 1963-64.

Navigator's Body Found in Wreckage

Idaho Falls — UPB — An Air Force rescue team Monday found the body of a missing navigator in the wreckage of a B47 that crashed Friday night into the snow-blanketed wilderness of Yellowstone National Park. Found with two other dead crewmen was Capt. Loren R. Matthews, 30, Bremer ton, Wash. There was only one survivor of the crash, Capt. Bruce A. Chapman, 33, of Mountain Home, Idaho, who managed to eject from the plunging craft.
