

Rainfall in GP Is Above April Normal

Grants Pass - Total precipitation here during April was far above average, but the 5.32 inches that fell still made it only the second wettest April in history, leaving the record of 5.74 inches, set in April of 1948 still standing.

The 15-year average for the month is 1.67 inches.

Although April marks the beginning of the climatological "dry season" here, precipitation was measured on 21 out of the 30 days; and the 5.32 inches which fell is already above the 4.77-inch average rainfall for the entire five-month season.

As a crowning touch, snow, which had not appeared all winter, was visible on the surrounding mountains throughout much of April.

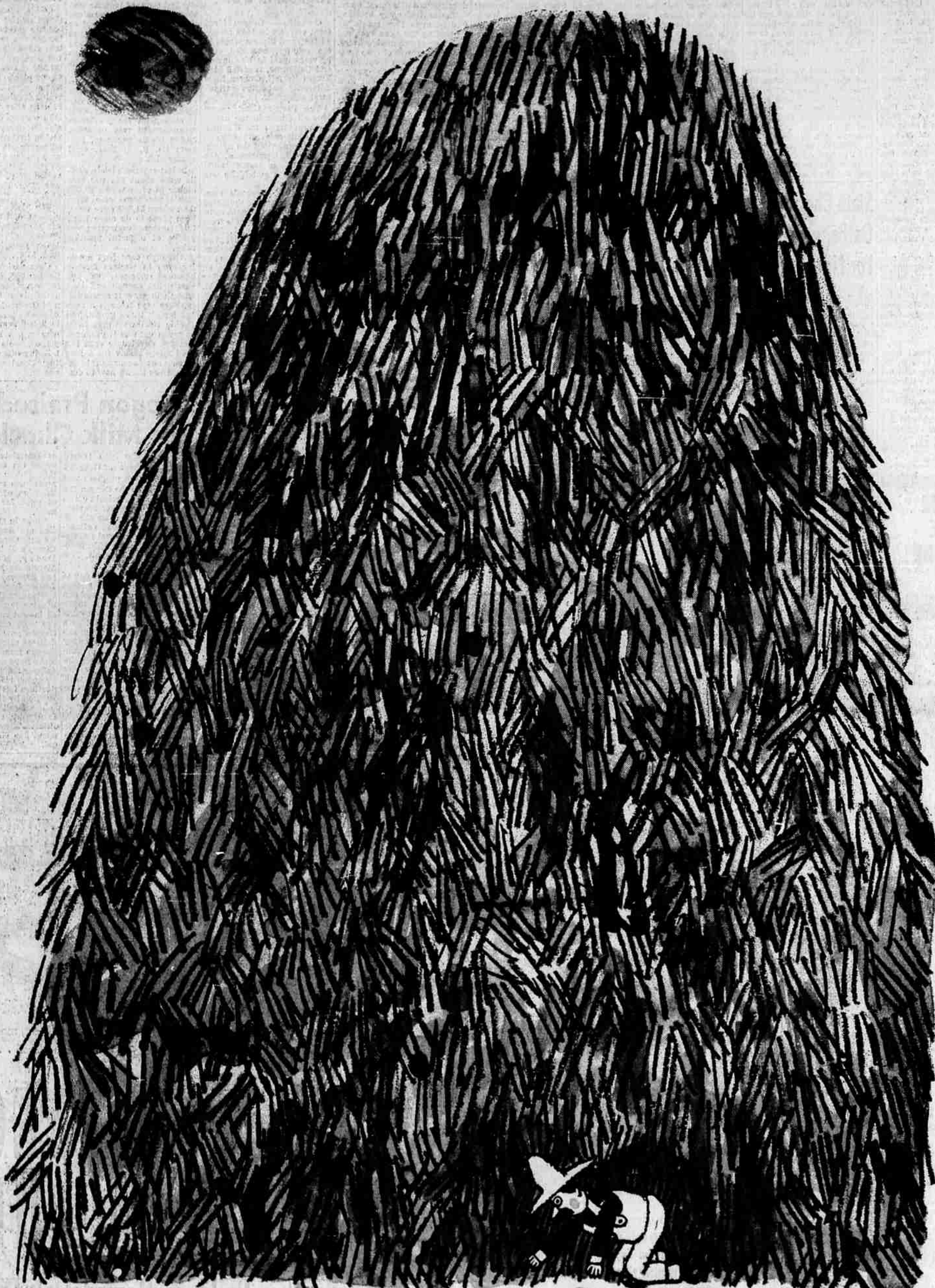
