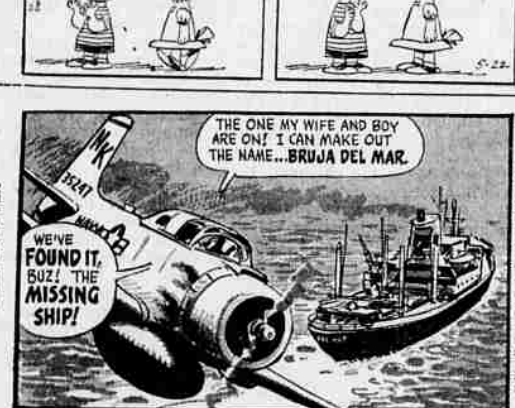

Civil Defense To Cease at Portland Portland - (UPI) - Portland's 13-year-old Civil Defense agency will be no more after July 1.

The City Council voted 4-1 Tuesday to abolish it. Mayor Terry Schunk cast the only vote to keep it. The action came when a \$56,000 budget was turned down.

Jack Lowe, city CD director, is one of 11 persons whose jobs will be affected. He was in Salem discussing CD with state officials at the time the vote was taken.

The decision means the \$630,000 Kelly Butte center, built in 1953, will be made obsolete, plus a halt to the federally-financed community fallout shelter program.

Civil defense duties likely will be carried out by a committee of city department heads. Schunk named a committee to phase out the program.

Mikoyan, Kozlov Said Incapacitated Moscow - (UPI) - Two of Premier Nikita Khrushchev's top deputies, Anastas Mikoyan and Frol Kozlov, today were reported ill.

Mikoyan's illness was disclosed Tuesday night. Informed sources said he had been in the hospital since early this month after coming down with influenza April 27, when he went to the Arctic Circle city of Murmansk to greet Cuban Premier Fidel Castro.
