Frankfurt, Germany—(AP) The man who might have won the war for Adolf Hitler, and almost did—Willy Messerschmitt—is back in the jet plane business.

There wasn't too much fanfare or even attention paid to the production of a jet fighter by Professor Willy's new plane made public debut. It was the day American Maj. L. Gordon Cooper went into space and the headlines went to him.

For a strange reason, the ME110 was almost Messerschmitt's undoing with the Nazis. It was one of those planes, with extra fuel tanks, that kept Hitler in 1941 in his muddled attempt at peace negotiations.
