**Amish Farmers Under Orders To Electrify Barns**

Lancaster, Pa. - (UPI) - Pennsylvania's Amish farmers have another problem caused by progress. The Amish, who traditionally have used portable kerosene or gasoline mantle lamps to light their barns and milk houses have been ordered to install electricity in their dairy facilities.

If they do not comply with the order of health authorities of Lower Merion Twp., near Philadelphia, they face the possibility of losing an estimated \$1.5 million a year in milk sales.

The Amish are a religious sect, many of whom shun such modern conveniences as automobiles and electricity.

**Will Enforce Rule**

But recently township authorities made an inspection tour of Amish dairy farms and passed the word that it would strictly enforce one of its rules that specifies electric lighting on farms supplying milk to the township.

Sealtest Dairy traditionally has bought milk from the Amish and is completely satisfied as to its quality. Sealtest even picks up milk on Saturday night and early Monday morning so as not to violate Amish religious principles against doing work on Sunday.

But when the township advised Sealtest that it would enforce the electricity regulation, it had no choice but to advise Amish suppliers to electrify their barns by March 1, 1964, or find other markets for their milk.

**Strict Regulations**

Approximately 200 Amish farmers shipping between 45,000 and 50,000 quarts of milk a day out of Leaman Place, Pa., are involved.

Lower Merion township is in milk control district 1-A, and their regulations - admittedly "very strict" - effectively serve to control milk supplies for other communities in the same district.

Sealtest, for example, could not afford to ignore a township health ruling and thereby lose its customers in that township and probably in the entire control district.

The Amish have nearly a year to decide whether or not they will adhere to their beliefs and sacrifice a substantial annual income.

**Neuberger Warns On Right Wingers**

Portland - (UPI) - Sen. Maurine Neuberger (D-Ore.) Sunday warned the Pacific Northwest regional conference of the AFL-CIO's Committee on Political Education of "tax exempt right wing groups."

Mrs. Neuberger told the labor group that "dozens of tax-exempt right wing groups masquerading as education or religious organizations are today flooding the country with extremist partisan political propaganda."

The Oregon Democrat said such organizations were financed by tax-free contributions from businessmen. She listed several organizations she said took in more than \$5.5 million of tax-exempt contributions annually.

Mrs. Neuberger said the tax-free incomes and the shield of respectability "cloak their right wing propaganda."
