**Mr. H. S.**—Roger is only 14, finishing up his first year of high school. I have better things to do with my vacation this year than to make the round of college campuses, but he has already sent for catalogs and wants to visit Harvard, Yale, Dartmouth and the rest. There's not a ghost of a chance he'll land in any of them. We plan to take over the family farm and it'll be Agricultural School for Roger. Why tantalize him?

**Mrs. H. S.**—Even if Roger studies scientific farming some day, he has the right to know of other possibilities; and maybe he can learn much more than just farming if he goes to one of the big universities. He was told to start thinking of colleges when he becomes a sophomore in high school, so he sent for preliminary information; but those catalogs all look alike. It would help Roger to plan if only his Dad would agree to tour through a few college towns with us.

The Council: Seeing those seats of learning in the flesh, or rather in the stone, brick, and ivy, certainly will make the dull wordy catalogs come alive, and will provide a worthwhile focus for a vacation itinerary for all the S's. But there may be little relationship between the proposed academic stopovers and Roger's serious hunt for his eventual alma mater, for the physical plant is only one of at least a dozen vital considerations. What of the faculty? What of the "feel"—is it one of earnestness, or of killing time? It is just a how-to-make-a-buck mill or, as Mrs. S. hopes, an institution dedicated to turning out enriched personalities?
