

**10 A Senate Committee Schedules Review Of Space Program**

Washington - (AP) - The nation's multi-billion dollar space program was to come under close congressional scrutiny today in Senate hearing committee hearings designed to assess its aims, activities, and costs.

Chairman Clinton P. Anderson (D-N. M.) is launching the inquiry with testimony from 10 distinguished scientists. The controversial man-to-the-moon project will be a central issue.

The hearing has political overtones. Just a month ago the staff of the Senate Republican policy committee issued a report on the moon program entitled "a matter of priority." The same day Sen. Margaret Chase Smith, Maine, the committee's top ranking Republican, wrote Anderson asking for an airing of the program's objectives, along with a study of the budget of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration.

Anderson responded by requesting testimony from the 10 witnesses who represent a wide range of views. Two days of hearings have been allotted.

Starting Wednesday, government witnesses, headed by NASA Administrator James E. Webb, will testify in support of the NASA money authorization bill. That measure is the necessary preliminary for the space agency's \$4.2 billion budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1.

**Highway Crashes Claim 22 Lives**

Four highway tragedies killed a total of 22 persons - including a father and six of his children - in Illinois, California and Canada within a few hours Saturday.

The spectacular crash occurred on the first summer vacation week end of the year and just one week after the nation set a record for the most number of persons killed during a summer-season holiday week end.

Saturday's worst collision was near Pontiac, Ill., where a vacationing father and six of his seven children perished in a car-truck smashup.

Five persons were killed in a four-car pileup at Millers, Calif., and two accidents in Ontario, Canada, claimed five lives each.

A car carrying Mr. and Mrs. Charles J. Koumplik of Rolling Meadows, Ill., and their children crashed into the rear of a parked truck on U. S. 66, just north of Pontiac, Ill., less than two hours after the family had started a vacation trip.

**Railroad Strike Deadline Nears**

Washington - (AP) - Time is running out rapidly on President Kennedy's efforts to block a paralyzing railroad shutdown that could come anytime after next Wednesday.

Top-level government mediators said Saturday there appeared to be scant chance of settling a three-year-old working rules dispute between the railroads and five unions before a Tuesday midnight deadline.

The carriers will be free at one minute after midnight to enforce the new rules. They would eliminate thousands of firemen on diesel engines and make sweeping changes in pay systems for 200,000 operating employees.

Union leaders have warned that such action would trigger a strike on 195 major roads.

**\$100,000 in Damages Sought in Complaint**

A complaint seeking \$100,000 general damages, \$116.50 medical expenses, and \$1,200 for lost wages, has been filed in Jackson county circuit court against the S-W Floor Cover Shop, 709 South Riverside ave.

Seeking the damages is Naomi Guss, 1041 Mt. Pitt ave., who, according to the complaint, was injured in May, 1962, while in the store. The complaint states that Mrs. Guss was struck by a six foot long steel T-square which fell, striking her on the head, left shoulder and elbow.
