

# Student Leaves for Summer in Turkey

To Work in Istanbul

Harlow Head, 1959 graduate of Medford High school, who received a bachelor of science degree in business administration at the University of Oregon Sunday, leaves today for Portland to board a plane for Istanbul, Turkey. Head is one of five University of Oregon students selected to work abroad this summer as part of the Oregon Association Internationale des Etudiants en Sciences Economiques et Commerciales program, better known as AIESEC-US.

The organization is a business-education venture designed to permit United States students to work abroad and to provide temporary jobs in America for visiting students. Head will work in an Istanbul bank. He will make the trip to Amsterdam in a University of Oregon chartered plane. From Amsterdam to Istanbul he will travel by train. His parents, Mr. and Mrs. Harold Head, 1415 Euclid ave., Medford, are motoring to Portland with him.

**Twelve Students**  
There are 12 students from the state of Oregon in the program. The other schools represented are: Portland State college, University of Portland and Lewis and Clark college. The 12 Oregon students are among the 260 selected across the nation for participation in the program this summer.

The trainee program is in its second year in Oregon. The international association of students is sponsoring the worldwide exchange of "working traineeships" to promote close and friendly relations between students of all nations.

**Student Administered**  
To become members of the traineeship program a student must apply through the local chapter. There is one at the University of Oregon, Head said. He made his application there which was then processed to the national headquarters in New York City.

## Survey Approved For Wall Creek Highway Section

Salem - (AP) - The State Highway Commission has authorized location surveys for major improvements on four Oregon highways.

Two are interstate highway system projects - the Wall Creek - California state line section of the Pacific Highway in Jackson county, which is 7.32 miles in length, and the Oxman - Benson creek section of the Old Oregon Trail highway in Baker and Malheur counties, which is 29.88 miles in length.

The other two surveys approved were for the Arnold Ice Cave Road - Horse Ridge section of Highway 20 in Deschutes county and the Independence Junction - Bonneville subsection section of the Williamson - Salem highway in Polk county.

**To Triple Park Size**  
The commission also authorized acquisition of 104 acres for addition to Detroit Lake State Park. This would triple the size of the existing park.

It authorized negotiations for acquiring 335 acres of additional land for developments at Hat Rock State Park in Umatilla county, Mayer State Park in Wasco county and Sunset Bay State Park in Coos county.

The commission approved seven projects in five counties as part of the \$694,000 construction work authorized on county federal - aid secondary highway system for fiscal 1964. The projects are in Benton, Deschutes, Gilliam, Polk and Washington counties.

Deschutes county plans to transfer a portion of its allotment to the State Highway department to spend on the Bachelor Mountain - Big Spring section of the Cascade Lakes Highway.

# Trip To Asylum for Folksingers Works in Reverse for Dick West

Washington - (AP) - As doorkeeper, parliamentarian and tally clerk of the National Organization of Stamp Out Folksinging in the Continental United States and Adjacent Tidelands (NOTSOFUSAT) I have become a



west prophet without honor in my own house. My daughter, having lived 12 years with no outward sign of mental instability, recently turned 13 and, in a tradition of teen-agers, immediately took leave of her senses.

She confided, after playing a Chad Mitchell record album 49 times non-stop, that her all-consuming ambition was to meet a real, live folksinger in the flesh in person. This from a girl who only a few short months ago had her heart set on becoming a female Albert Schweitzer.

I did what any father would do under such circumstances. I had my will and testament revised, striking her name from the list of legatees who were jointly to inherit my collection of Rudy Vallee records.

Then I took the case to a teenage psychologist, who recommended the shock treatment. Her fixation might be broken, he said, by over-exposure to folksingers.

Fortunately - or, as it turned out unfortunately - I knew just the place to undertake such a cure. The Shoreham Hotel, an occasional waystop on the Hootenanny circuit, was giving asylum to an abundance of folksingers who travel under the name of the Brothers Four.

Using my influence as one of the officers of NOTSOFUSAT, I discreetly arranged for my daughter to meet them and to hear their rendition of such haunting cantatas as "Keep Your Cotton-Pickin' Hands Off My Leather Jacket, It's the Nearest Thing

I've Got to Skin, Mother."

When next I saw her, she was clapping her right forearm with her left hand. My first thought was that the treatment had exceeded expectations and that she had slashed her wrist. It turned out, however, that her right hand had been defiled by handshakes with the Brothers Four and she was holding it aloft as a safeguard against contamination.

"I'll never use this hand again," she vowed, her tremulous soprano suddenly gone husky.

Although it failed to produce the intended results, the experiment did prove a point. It shows that you can't create toxicity to folksinging merely by saturating the subject with folksingers.

"I never dreamed just from listening to records that folksingers were so young and handsome," my daughter said as she put the album on the turntable for the 81st time.

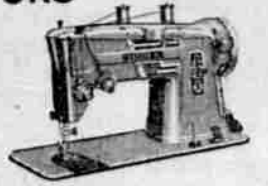
That was where I made my mistake. I should have taken her to see Burl Ives.

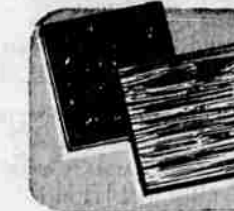

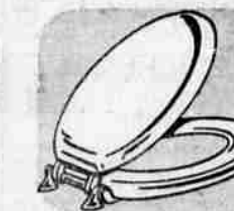

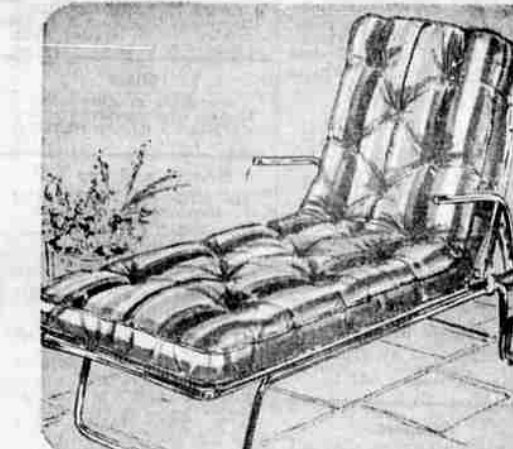
