**Rooster Crowing Contest Slated**

Rogue River—The 1963 National Rooster Crowing contest will be held at Rogue River Saturday, June 29.

The annual event, formerly staged on the third Saturday in June, was delayed to permit the development of a more extensive program.

This year, the Crow will take on more of a home town carnival and fair atmosphere, according to Millie Oliver, publicity chairman for the Rogue River Chamber of Commerce sponsored event.

Cash prizes will be awarded, as usual, to the rooster crowing the most times during a given period on the day of the contest. The contest will open at noon.

Offering advice to prospective contestants, the committee suggests that owners cage their birds for several days before the contest and move them into new surroundings so they will be well adjusted when they arrive at Rogue River June 29.

It is also best to keep the cage covered or dark until close to contest time. "When the wraps are taken off, the bird is then deceived into thinking that morning has come and he starts crowing," the committee noted.
