Rog Spoils Theory of Experts

It's 5-1 Roger Maris again today in the New York Yankee clubhouse and around the American league.

Because the man who set the all-time mark of 61 homers in a season in 1961 only to be one of the disappointments of the 1962 campaign is proving that he does not need Mickey Mantle to soften up pitchers for him. In short, that he, too, can be a leader. The experts questioned that last year when Maris failed to hit while Mantle was out of the lineup and they horted

that it would happen again this season when Mickey suffered a broken bone in his left foot which will sideline him until sometime next month.

It's a wonderful theory for those who hope this will be one of those rare years in which the Yankees do not win the American league pennant but it's being drowned out by the thunder of Maris' bat.

The Yankees have reeled off five straight victories and it's no coincidence that Maris has walloped away at a .500 clip during those five games. The 9-for-18 splurge has lifted his season average to .289 and he's connected for 11 homers and driven in 21 runs.

Maris made it easy for Whitey Ford to post his ninth win of the season Tuesday night when he hit two homers and a single in the Yankee's 10-5 triumph over the Washington Senators. Tom Tresh and Tony Kubek also homered and Hector Lopez had a triple as the Yankees moved a full game ahead of the Chicago White Sox, who lost to the Minnesota Twins, 5-3.

The Cleveland Indians defeated the Baltimore Orioles, 7-3, the Boston Red Sox routed the Detroit Tigers, 9-0, and the Los Angeles Angels scored an 11-inning, 2-1 victory

over the Kansas City Athletics in other AL games.

Harmon Killebrew's 11th homer of the season helped the Twins drop the White Sox a full game behind the Yankees. Jim Perry pitched eight hit ball for seven innings and Bill Dalley closed it out with two strong relief innings. Joel Horlen suffered his second defeat against four wins for the White Sox.

Barry Latham pitched a five-hitter and contributed to a two-run double to an attack that carried the Indians to their sixth straight victory and their 16th in the last 18 games. Latham struck out 10 en route to his third win. Willie Kirkland homered for the Indians and Jim Gentile connected for the Orioles.

The Red Sox spotted Charlie Dressen's debut as manager of the Tigers as Earl Wilson pitched a four-hitter and homers by Eddie Bresnoud and Dick Stuart paced Boston's late-inning attack. It was the eighth straight loss for the Tigers, playing their first game under Dressen after Bob Scheffing was fired.

A wild pitch with the bases filled by John Wyatt enabled the Angels to score the winning run against the Athletics in the 11th inning. Ken McBride pitched a three-hitter and struck out seven in going the distance to win his seventh game against six losses.

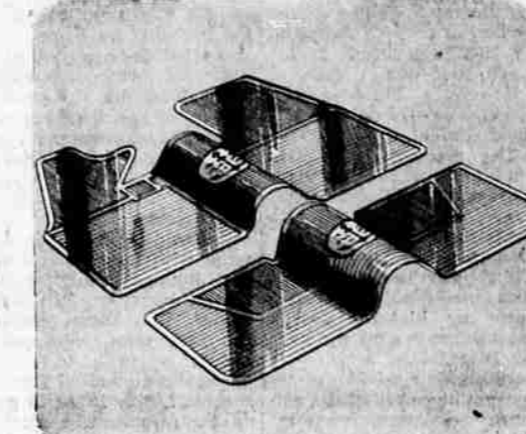

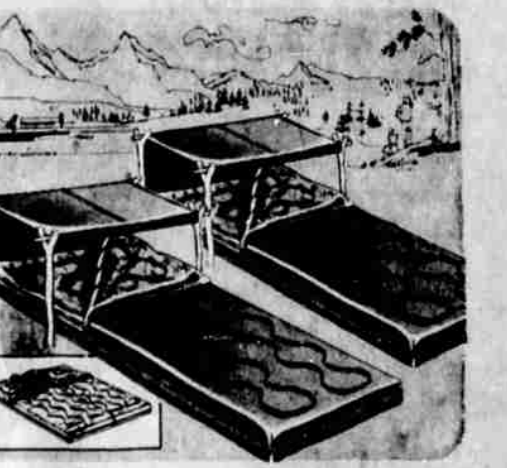
