Fire Damages Car Agency in Lakeview

Lakeview - The Fairleigh Ford agency here was heavily damaged by fire Tuesday night.

Several firemen were treated for smoke inhalation, but no serious injuries were reported.

The flames, which were reported about 10:45 p.m., caused heavy damage to the two-story building and an estimated 28 to 32 cars were ruined by the blaze.

Cause of the blaze was not immediately known.

APPROVES BILL - Washington - The House Armed Services Committee Tuesday approved a bill to authorize awarding the Medal of Honor and other top decorations to Americans serving in such cold war combat areas as Viet Nam.

Hearing Slated in Truck Tax Dispute

Salem - A hearing has been set for July 2-3 in Salem to settle a dispute between Pacific Motor Trucking Co. and the public utility commissioner over payment of \$30,000 in road-use taxes.

The hearing was called to determine the intent of the legislature in 1961 when it amended the road-use tax law to exempt certain mail-carrying routes from taxation.

The PUC claims the trucking firm owes the taxes for non-mail freight it carried. The trucking firm says the law exempted it from all road-use taxes over the Portland-Ashland haul which was handled by Southern Pacific Railroad until 1955 when rail service was suspended.

Portland - S. J. Gjerde of Portland was elected president of the Oregon Bankers association at the close of its 58th annual convention Tuesday.

Gjerde, senior vice president of the Oregon Bank in Portland, succeeds M. L. Walden of Taft.

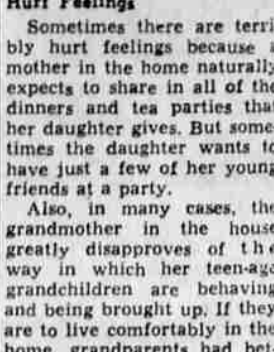
U.S. Accused of Buildup in Viet Nam
