Dozens of Stars Attend Premier

Hollywood - (UPI) - The lavish days of Hollywood were recalled Wednesday night as dozens of stars turned out to see the motion picture "Cleopatra" in one of the largest fund-raising premieres in history.

More than \$1 million was collected in the benefit for the Los Angeles Music Center. Seats sold at \$250, but many contributions were made beyond the 1,511 seat capacity of the sold out Pantages Theater.

During the intermission for the picture, actress Rosalind Russell announced that \$1,094,403.06 was raised for the music center, assuring that construction of the center theater, one of three, can begin this year. It is the only one not yet fully financed.

The \$25 million music center for the performing arts is being built on the crest of a hill that overlooks the Los Angeles Civic Center. About half of the total cost is being underwritten by the county of Los Angeles while the rest is being raised by private contributions.

The music center building fund committee is headed by Mrs. Norman Chandler, wife of Norman Chandler, president and chairman of the board of the Times Mirror Co.

The Chandlers attended the premiere as did their son, Otis Chandler, publisher of the Los Angeles Times, and his wife.
