Mid-West, Eastern State People Visiting Park

Many mid-west and eastern state residents, who visited the fair in Seattle last year, are returning this year for another stay at Crater Lake, according to Ralph Peyton, operator of Crater Lake Lodge.

Reservations at the lodge by people from the mid-west and Atlantic Coast states are heavier this year than ever before, Peyton said.

The 35-mile rim drive around the lake is open. It was closed for a short time Sunday by the snow storm, reported at the higher elevations, but was reopened in the afternoon.

In addition to Crater Lake lodge, three public campgrounds are now open to provide overnight accommodations to lake visitors.

About 40 per cent of the tourists visiting Crater Lake, according to Peyton, drive in on Highway 97 from the north entrance to the park.

Another 40 per cent drive Highway 97 from the south and some 20 per cent of the visitors drive along Rogue river on Highway 62 out of Medford.

All highways are in good condition, Peyton said.
