Indian Sect Has Mass Weddings

Khote, India - (UPI) - India's bearded, fighting Sikhs celebrated the 100th anniversary of a unique custom - mass weddings - in a joint ceremony for 140 couples here.

Two of the bridegrooms came from Thailand and another from Uganda to be married in the spot where the Namdhari sect of Sikhs first introduced the multiple ceremony.

The sect began the practice of mass weddings on June 3, 1863, with the object of sparing its members the huge expenses which normally accompany an Indian marriage ceremony.

This still is the objective. The couples who were wed here paid from 75 cents to \$2.50 to tie the knot and were strictly forbidden to accept dowries from the brides' parents.

The brides and bridegrooms stand in a giant circle while attendants tie the ends of their robes together. Then they circle four times around a sacred fire while a priest chants verses from the Sikh holy book, the Granth Sahib.

The inexpensive, 90-minute ceremony ends when the couples untie the knots that connect their robes and eat small dishes of a wheat pudding which has been blessed by the priests.

A million of India's 8 million Sikhs belong to the Namdhari sect. Their wedding customs contrast sharply with those of their Hindu fellow countrymen, who often spend as much as \$10,000 on a 24-hour celebration, or give furniture, clothing, gold and automobiles for the bride's dowry.
