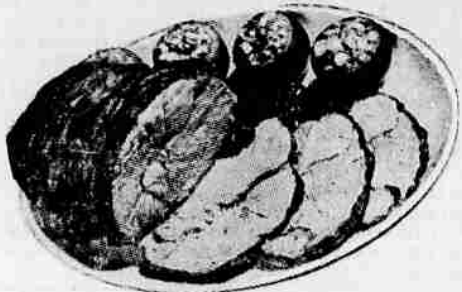

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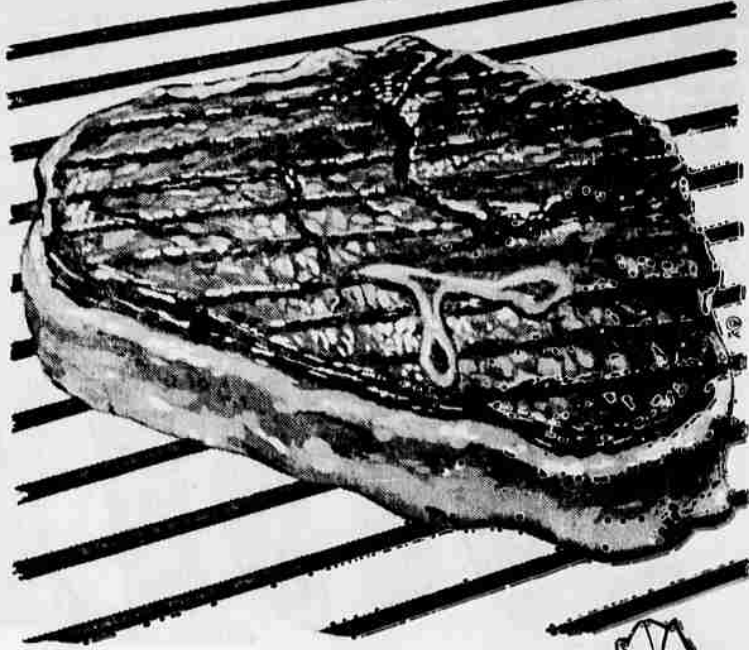

**Eisenhower Heads For 'Adventure Into Nostalgia'**

New York - (UPI) - Former President Dwight D. Eisenhower was bound today for an "adventure into nostalgia" along the beaches of Normandy and in England.

Eisenhower thus described his one-week trip to Europe with his wife, Mamie, during a news conference Wednesday aboard the Queen Elizabeth shortly before the liner sailed.

"I plan to walk up and down the Normandy beaches and visit Portsmouth, England," he said. The decision to launch the D-Day Allied invasion of France was reached in a conference room at Portsmouth.

**To Probe FWH**

The former Chief Executive, who is visiting to make a television documentary film dealing with the invasion, also said current Negro civil rights demonstrations evoked "the rightful discontent of a minority."

"I understand their purposes," he said. "I agree with those who say they are entitled to their just rights. I disagree with all things that become so violent that they have contrary effects."

"If they call attention to their discontent by proper demonstrations, I feel it is all right," he said.

**Special Obligations**

"Every individual in the United States has a legal and moral obligation to see others enjoy the same rights. We must eliminate every possibility of differentiating between political and economic rights on the basis of color."

Eisenhower said he would reserve comment on the recently signed partial nuclear test ban among the United States, Britain and the Soviet Union "because we still have to hear military and scientific opinions on the whole thing."

On the GOP presidential nomination, he said that he could strongly support "anyone who has been mentioned for the Republican candidacy... because I think we can get better leadership from them than we are getting now from the present administration."

**First Air Trips For 500,000**

Chicago - (UPI) - More than a half million Americans will be elevated to new heights this year - via the nation's commercial airliners.

A survey compiled by United Air Lines showed that over half these novice air travelers will be traveling over routes they once favored by car, train or bus. A majority will journey more than 1,000 miles from home.

Shorter travel time is the prime object of three-fourths of the new flyers, according to A. J. Beverett, market research manager for United.

"To illustrate, a family living in Ohio or New York can easily spend 12 or 14 vacation days at a West Coast vacation spot if they fly there and back," he said.

Half the first-time flyers will be vacation-bound, the survey indicated. Women appear to be the most adventurous - some in the survey results, as 60 per cent of these experimenting with air travel will be female.

Breaking down the different types taking first plane trips this year, the survey shows that 23 per cent will be housewives, another 23 per cent will be professional and business people; 20 per cent will be students; 10 per cent will be secretaries and clerical employees, and 5 per cent will be retired people.

The remainder will come from other walks of life, particularly farming, Beverett said.

First-time flyers will find they must cut down on luggage to 40 pounds, but they can bring their pets in special airplane kennels.

Of those people embarking on air travel, 97 per cent found their first trip satisfactory or most pleasant and 3 per cent indicated disappointment, according to the United survey.
