Submarine Design May Be Changed

Farmingdale, N.Y. - UPI - A pioneer airplane-building company is turning its attention downward here to help improve U.S. Navy submarine operations. The design, development and fabrication of unique plastic rudders for use within the Navy's experimental deep-diving submarine AGSS-555 (Dolphin) is under way at Republic Aviation. Although conventional in appearance, the plastic rudders are to be based on a new concept in lightweight design, using special material developed by the company.

Successful sea tests of this new rudder could cause a marked change in the design and construction of external control surfaces on new submarines, according to RAC.

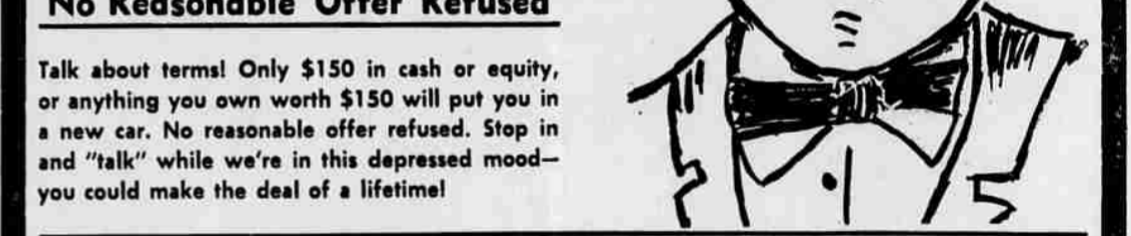

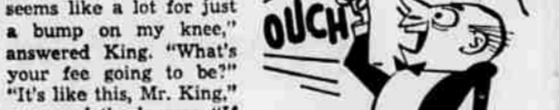
