Carl S. — He's just a show-off, always trying to get attention.

Irving P. — I just believe in following my impulses and being natural.

Carl S. — I'm beginning to regret signing up to share a dormitory room with Irving when we report to start college in the fall. We're counselors at the same camp this summer and I see a side of him I can't stand. He's a faker, all show. He tricks people, charms them to win an immediate advantage. But there's no sincerity. Behind their back, he laughs at them.

Irving P. — Carl is sore because I beat him to the best assignment on this job. The trouble with him is he's so rigid—everything must be done by the book. Well, I believe in cutting corners to get what you want, to grab it before the squares like Carl know what's happening. He'll be glad he's rooming with me in college. I'll give him pointers on how to live.

The Council: Long before Oscar Wilde's downfall, he was behaving "Widely." And Irving's philosophy, if not his behavior, sounds flamboyant and Wilde-like. Thus Carl does him the good turn of glaring at it in summer's bright light and seeing it as a road to self-destruction, similar to the irresistible one the lemmings take to their deaths. The fact is, Irving, that there is order in the universe. Running counter to the basic "musts" — as does the wiseguy — ultimately proves suicidal. Integrity is one of these musts. Self-control, that is, the ability to defer gratification rather than grab it, is another. (Witness the belly-ache that usually follows from having the ice cream before the corned beef) . . . You can be natural, and still be prudent. Brooks Atkinson points out that Shaw had similar endowments to Wilde's, but he succeeded where Wilde failed because he deferred to the needs of others. Wilde fell victim to "self-infatuation" . . . Heed Carl's warning. Start saving yourself by serving the just interests of others—Carl, for instance.

**Subdivision Reports May Now Be Filed**

Owners of subdivisions located in Oregon are advised by Real Estate Commissioner Robert J. Jensen that reports required under the Oregon Subdivision Control Law, effective Sept. 2, may be filed at this time.

Report forms, known as a "preliminary notice of intention" to sell or lease subdivided land, are available without charge at the real estate department offices at 112 Labor and Industries building, Salem, and 378 State Office building, Portland.

No fee is required for filing the report. Under the provisions of the law, the Commissioner is authorized to waive further report filing after an examination of the preliminary report.

Commissioner Jensen has stated that as a general policy, waivers will be issued after filing of the preliminary notice for subdivisions located within this state, created under the jurisdiction of a city or county authority specified in ORS Chapter 92, and which are not advertised for sale outside this state.

After Sept. 2 it will be unlawful to offer for sale or lease any lot or parcel in a subdivision until the provisions of the new law have been complied with. By taking advantage of the early filing, subdividers can avoid delays resulting from congestion on the effective date of the law. A tract of land partitioned into four or more lots is a subdivision.

**San Francisco Bay Area Feels Quake**

San Francisco—A sharp earthquake jarred the San Francisco Bay area Sunday, but there were no reports of damage and only one reported injury.

William T. Hickey said he was making planter boxes in the basement of his San Francisco home and had a hammer in midair when the quake struck. He was treated at Park Emergency hospital for a smashed thumb.

The tremor struck at 10:33 a.m. (pdt). It was felt from Pacific south of San Francisco to San Rafael, 20 miles to the north.
