It takes a little more thought to design a home where the hall is accessible from the service, which eliminates much foot traffic through the kitchen. The ultimate in center hall planning is when an exterior door opens from the hall to the outside of the house. All of these are offered in this distinctive four-bedroom home.

Entry Door Recessed

The front entry door has been recessed to provide complete protection from the elements. The entry is well lighted by a stationary window next to the door and the same height as the door.

From the living room, a wide view of the street is possible through a large picture window. A view of the rear yard plus access to the generous size patio is available from the sliding glass doors in the dining ell. The handsome corner fireplace can be enjoyed from any place in either the living room or dining ell.

Run-Off Considered On TFX Contract

Washington - (UPI) - Sen. Karl E. Mundt (R-S.D.) said today that a plan for a run-off competition for the TFX fighter plane contract was being given "some thought" by the Senate investigators.

Under the proposal, General Dynamics Corporation and the Boeing Company would build prototype planes each. The best one would win the competition and the contract for its company.

However, Mundt said the idea was not "finalized," but was "among the possible recommendations" considered by a subcommittee investigating the controversy over the contract.

Mundt said he had received a lot of favorable mail on the idea.

However, Pentagon witnesses so far have rejected any proposal for a winner-take-all competition on the super-sonic fighter.

The initial research contract was awarded to the General Dynamics Company eight months ago, despite recommendations by some military officials that the award go to Boeing.

IT'S YOUR LAW

Respect for Law Makes Democracy Live

STARTING A LAWSUIT

The thought of starting a lawsuit may cross your mind, and you have only the slightest idea of when to sue and how to start a suit.

Our laws give us a written guarantee that the courts will see to it that we are repaid money we loan, or that people we deal with will keep their word when we make a contract, or that we'll get what we are reasonably entitled to if hurt because of another person's negligence.

Question of Court

The law gives us the right to go to court. That, we know. Which court is the right one? Is the claim small enough to be handled by a Justice of the Peace? Or must we go to the District Court, or even the Federal court? Are we entitled to anything beyond the doctor bill or garage bill for all the trouble we've been through? Is it damages we want, or an injunction, or a writ of replevin?

If we demand a money judgment for some wrong, or loss, or injury suffered because of another person's actions, we'd be asking for damages.

In addition to recovering actual expenses for the services of someone like a doctor or a mechanic, and receiving the equivalent of whatever pay is lost from being unable to work, we might be entitled to damages for our pain and suffering in case there's personal injury.

Perhaps we've been subject to ridicule, or loss of business, or our reputation has

been given a bad name either through vicious gossip, malicious printed statements, or false arrest. We might claim damages.

Injunction Suit

We may want the court only to enforce an agreement we have with someone by directing him to perform a specified act. Maybe we want to stop or prohibit an action or circumstances that will cause us harm. Then it's an injunction suit we want.

Maybe we want to get back something other than money loaned. This is known as "replevin."

What it is, we'd be almost certain to come out ahead in the long run because we think about suing only as a last resort, and only when our conscience tells us we are dead right. We have faith that the law will protect us, that a court will see that justice is done.

Foreign Vessels For Lumber Sought

Washington - (UPI) - Rep. Jack Westland (R-Wash.) joined today in an effort to win permission for West Coast lumber shippers to use foreign flag vessels between U.S. ports.

Westland said he had introduced legislation to allow such use of foreign vessels now prohibited by U.S. shipping laws. Similar bills already have been introduced by other Pacific Northwest members of congress.

However, Westland said, his bill also would make permanent a temporary authorization to use foreign flag vessels for carrying lumber to Puerto Rico. The authorization, approved last year by congress, expires Oct. 24.

Both measures are intended to help the West Coast lumber industry meet Canadian competition on U.S. East Coast markets.

Westland said use of lower-cost foreign vessels had helped U.S. lumber producers recapture part of the Puerto Rican market.

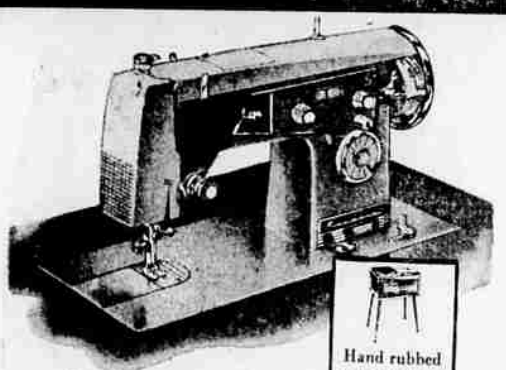
