

### Johnson, Coleman Due for Runoff In Mississippi

Jackson, Miss. — (UPI) — Lt. Gov. Paul B. Johnson and former Gov. J. P. Coleman, both committed to resist integration at every level, Wednesday built up leads that would apparently put them in an Aug. 27 runoff for the Democratic nomination for governor.

Johnson, 47, who lost three previous tries to win the office once held by his father, was virtually assured of a place in the runoff to pick a successor to Gov. Ross Barnett, prohibited by law from succeeding himself.

Coleman, who defeated Johnson in a runoff for governor eight years ago, maintained a lead of more than 8,000 votes over attorney Charles Sullivan as the slow tabulation of votes from Tuesday's primary continued.

With 1,307 of the state's 1,888 precinct's tabulated and reports coming in from scattered incomplete precincts, Johnson had 102,519. Coleman had 81,911 and Sullivan 73,595.

Retired welder Robert Mason, who said he entered the race because he liked to make speeches, was a distant fourth with less than 2,000 votes.

The two front runners will vie in the primary three weeks away with the winner then facing Republican Rubel Phillips, a former Democrat making the GOP's first serious bid for the governor's chair since Reconstruction, in November.

Johnson, Coleman and Sullivan all pledged to uphold segregation but varied in their proposals to do it.

Johnson and Sullivan bitterly criticized President Kennedy for sending troops to force the enrollment of a Negro in the University of Mississippi last fall.

Coleman, a onetime Kentucky supporter, was not as vociferous as his two opponents but disavowed his former friendship with the President. Coleman said Johnson, in trying to help Barnett physically block the enrollment of James Meredith, was politically motivated.

### Disabled People May Get Benefits

People who are severely disabled may be eligible for social security benefits, according to Edward B. Jacobson, district manager in Medford.

Individuals having an illness or injury which is expected to be of long continued duration may qualify for benefits if they are under the age of 65 and have worked in employment covered by the Social Security Law in at least five of the ten years before their disability stopped them from working. Benefits may be paid commencing with the seventh month of disability.

Jacobson urged that disabled workers and their families who are not receiving disability payments immediately contact their Social Security office and make inquiry as to their eligibility for benefits.

He said anyone who is unable to go to the office should write or phone and a representative would contact them at their residence. The Medford office is located at 1017 North Riverside ave. and the telephone number is 773-7348.

### Caesarean Section Long Practiced

Otis ABF, Mass. — (UPI) — Mrs. John F. Kennedy gave birth to all three of her children by Caesarean section, a technique so-called in the belief that Julius Caesar was born in the same manner.

The operation involves an incision in the abdomen and the wall of the uterus to reach the baby. Such a delivery is prescribed in cases where normal delivery is regarded as being difficult or impossible.

Roman law specified that the operation be performed on any women believed dying in advanced pregnancy. According to medical historians, the Senate of Venice imposed the death penalty on any practitioner who failed to perform a Caesarean section on a dying pregnant woman.

However, the earliest recorded case of Caesarean section was that of a Swiss who operated on his wife nearly 500 years ago.

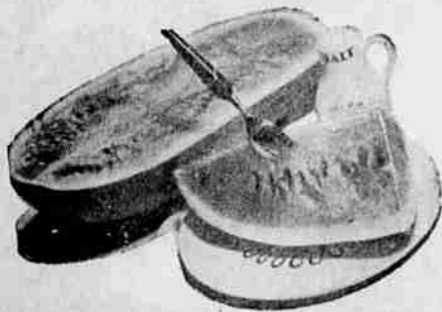

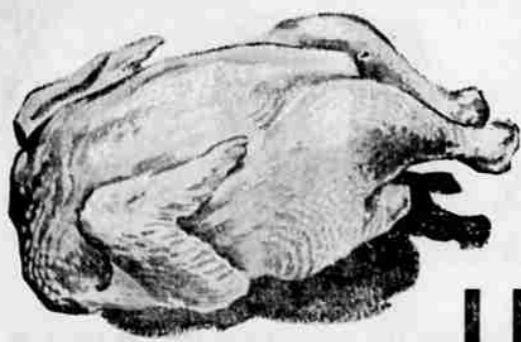
