



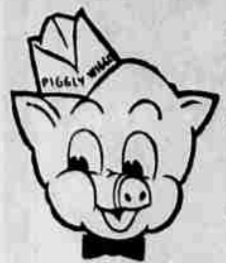

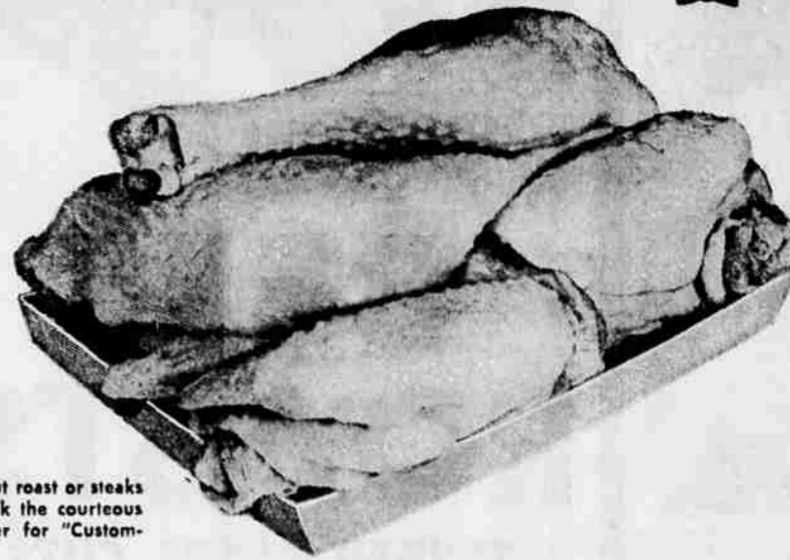

Atlanta—(UPI)—Cocky Mickey Cohen, who sneered at gangsters' bombs and bullets, lay in a prison hospital today with a fractured skull, the victim of a touchy forger from South Carolina.

A neurosurgeon said "48 hours will tell the tale" of the effect the bloody beating will have on the West Coast mobster.

Officials at Atlanta Federal Prison said Cohen, serving 15 years for income tax evasion, was "progressing very satisfactorily" and would live. The neurosurgeon had to operate Wednesday to relieve the pressure on Cohen's brain shortly after a fellow inmate hit him on the head three times with a three-foot length of pipe.

Restful Night
Cohen "spent a restful night" under sedation, sources said.

Warden D. M. Heritage said Cohen was sitting in the radio-television workshop talking to a guard when Berl Estes McDonald pounced on him from behind with the inch-wide pipe.

Heritage and FBI officials were quick to announce that the beating was the result of a "personal quarrel" between Cohen and McDonald, a 32-year-old forger from St. Stephen, S.C.

McDonald, in addition to his one-to-ten year sentence for forgery, was serving ten years for assault with intent to murder a fellow inmate at Leavenworth Federal Prison.

Moved From Alcatraz
Both Cohen, a flashy, 49-year-old former California gambling czar, and McDonald were transferred here last February when Alcatraz prison was closed down.

"It was a personal disagreement between two men in prison," Heritage said. He would not elaborate, he said, because it "might prejudice" trial of the assault with intent to murder charges filed against McDonald.

It was not the first time Cohen shed blood in a "personal disagreement." He was shot and wounded at least twice in California, and came through several other gangland shootings and two bomb blasts at his home unscathed.

Bids Opened for Building Projects At Oregon Tech

Portland—(UPI)—Bids were opened here Wednesday for more than \$1.1 million worth of work on a new residence dormitory and a small radioactive isotopes laboratory building for Oregon Technical Institute in Klamath Falls.

The work, to be completed by fall term of 1964, is for Phase 2B of OTI campus reconstruction. The residence hall will serve 328 students.

The bids were taken under advisement.

Apparent low bidders included: General construction: Halvorson Inc., Spokane, \$814,717. There were two other bidders.

Mechanical work: Urban Plumbing and Heating Co., Portland, \$143,717. There were four other bidders.

Electrical work: Ace Electric, Portland \$62,959. There were three other bidders.

Built-in furniture for the dormitory: Reliance Engineering and Manufacturing Corp., San Antonio, Tex., \$153,959. There were three other bidders.
