Highway Use Tax on Trucks Due Aug. 31

Portland-Highway vehicle truck owners or operators should pay the federal use tax on motor vehicles used on the public highways by Aug. 31, according to A. G. Erickson, director of internal revenue in Oregon. Payment must be received by Sept. 3, because the last regular day for filing falls on a non-workday. Erickson said that Form 2290 should be used for filing purposes.
