**BUDAPEST DECLARED INFECTIOUS AREA**  
Budapest, Hungary—(UPI)—Hungarian authorities, faced with the threat of an outbreak of smallpox, today declared Budapest an "infectious area."

**Men Jailed Due To Traffic Charge**

Two Milwaukie, Ore., men were jailed Friday as an outgrowth of the failure of one of them to appear in Medford municipal court to answer to a traffic charge.

Homer Hamilton Britain, Jr., 18, was lodged in city jail on a charge of failure to pay a fine. Robert Eugene De Shores, 30 was sentenced to five days in county jail on a contempt of court charge.

Britain had been scheduled to appear Friday morning in municipal court in connection with an accident on Aug. 9. He was the driver of a car which collided with a bicycle ridden by Richard Morgan, 20, of 901 Wabash ave.

Britain failed to appear, but De Shores showed up in court and told Municipal Judge Pro Tem Russell W. DeForrest that Britain was out of town.

City police later in the day arrested Britain in Medford, and subsequently the contempt of court warrant was issued for De Shores.

**Flags Dedicated At Trinity Church**

Ashland—Two new silk flags stand on either side of the chancel in Trinity Episcopal church. Their dedication was made a part of the service Aug. 25 when the Rev. Duane Alvord blessed the new Christian and national emblems given as a memorial to the late Lydia McCall.

Miss McCall, daughter of southern Oregon pioneers and a native of Ashland, died last September at the age of 91. She had long been active in the parish and the community. She was a past worthy matron of Alpha chapter, Order of Eastern Star, and a past regent of Mt. Ashland chapter, Daughters of the American Revolution.

The rector paid tribute to Miss McCall's faithful and dedicated service to the church and her love of country saying "It is entirely fitting that these two symbols with all their meaning should be dedicated to her memory."

**Utah Mine Blast Probe Scheduled**

Meath, Utah—(UPI)—Federal and state mining experts made preparations today for entering the Texas Gulf Sulphur company's potash mine near here to try and determine what triggered a blast that snuffed out the lives of 18 men.

The investigators will go into the mine Tuesday, just one week after the explosion that killed the men and trapped seven others.

The trapped miners survived the blast and later were rescued. A 20-man crew continued work a half mile below the surface of the ground, attempting to clear debris and pump out water so the investigation can be
