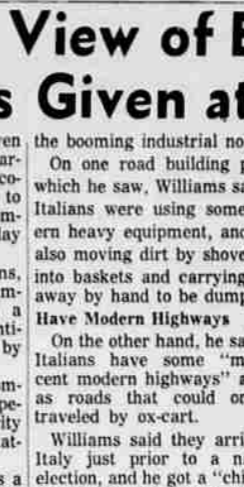
Tourist's View of European Countries Given at Roundtable

A tourist's eye view of seven European countries, with particular attention to their economic condition, was given to the Medford Chamber of Commerce Roundtable at its Monday noon luncheon.

The speaker, Bill Williams, president of the Medford chamber, returned in June from a three month's tour of the continent. He was accompanied by his wife and two daughters.

Williams prefaced his comments by disclaiming any special qualifications or authority as an expert on European matters. "I simply regard myself as a kind of typical American tourist," he said, "making his first trip to Europe."

Williams admitted they had seen "very little" of Spain, but said they had seen what was "most depressing." He said he felt the economy had "no vitality," and that the people were dejected and oppressed with poverty and governmental tyranny.

Williams described Italy as a country of "tremendous contrasts," one which is divided into two sections—the poverty-stricken agricultural south, and

encountered such rudeness and discourtesy as he did with the French. The speaker said he was particularly interested in the "dwarf stock" pear and apple trees he observed in the Rhone valley. The trees stand about five or six feet high, completely eliminating the necessity for ladders during harvesting.

Prosperity is High He said he found prosperity "very high" in France, a fact which he found largely true of northern Europe in general. Laborers are being imported for unskilled work from Spain and

Italy, he said. In Switzerland, he said he was impressed by the "international attitude" of the people, whom he regarded as "enterprising and thrifty." He found a "very great hatred of Russia" in Austria, and encountered his first vocal appreciation for U.S. foreign aid assistance in Vienna.

Williams' time ran out before he could comment on the other countries he had visited, but Roundtable Chairman Bob Balk expressed the hope that he could be scheduled for a repeat appearance in the near future to finish his talk.
