Is the daily walk losing its fun reputation with youngsters? Is it in danger of disappearing altogether from our automobile oriented society? The National Shoe Institute is doing its part to put the excitement back in junior pedestrianism with the gayest lot of young footwear in many a moon.

For boys, the friendly, famil-

iar names stand forth; oxfords, moccasins, slippers, but in up-to-the-minute patterns and with such clever construction they spell value in every last. Crepe soled styles are around to give boys' feet a comfort bounce while brushed and waxy leathers in fresh new shades of brown and olive tan give their shoes a good-looks lift. Fashion and function play footsie in the adolescent as well as in the adult world.

Hardly Know Oxfords

As for the girls, take their oxfords! You'd hardly know them! A brown grained leather has a reptile front and vamp, while a black plush tie with a wedge heel has a saffron suede vamp with dashes of rose and blue. Watch these harlequin color combinations, splashes and appliques, all a part of the storybook joy in children's shoes to take them dancing down the street for that daily walk. Take care of those joyous feet, mother and dad. They'll walk all through life in comfort if you shoe them fittingly now.

Larger Women Should Choose Shoes Wisely

The larger woman is often known as the "Woman of Distinction." Frequently, because of size alone, she appears more mature than a slender woman, so it is extremely important for her to choose flattering, youthful footwear.

She would be wise to select a well balanced shoe with cubed mid-heels or sculptured slender heels in the new lowered version.
