Survivors include one brother, Albert Finke, Gold Hill; two sisters, Mrs. Jenny K. Han, Phoenix, and Mrs. Alice Falls, Whittier, Calif., and a sister-in-law, Mary Josie Finke.

Mr. Goodwyn was born Dec. 26, 1861, in Morning Sun, Iowa. On Jan. 16, 1907, in Keokuk, Iowa, she was married to Charles Earl Horne, who preceded her in death in 1959. She attended school in Iowa, and moved to Oregon in 1921. She had been making her home in Forest Glen Senior Residence in Canyonville, Ore.

Survivors include two sons, Paul H. Horne, Klamath Falls, Ore., and Dr. Harry D. Horne, Seattle, Wash.; a daughter, Mrs. Helen Evans, Eugene, Ore.; two brothers, Dr. Robert H. Harris, Albany, Ore., and Dr. Verne O. Harris, Snohomish, Wash., and a niece.
