Rare Antitoxin Used to Prevent Botulism Deaths

KNOXVILLE, Tenn. (UPI)—Doctors sought, through the use of a rare antitoxin, today to prevent the death toll from a suspected outbreak of botulism from rising above seven.

Supplies of the rare and expensive anti-toxin were flown here from Canada and Denmark to supplement the United States' small supply.

Medical authorities here said "we believe we have enough serum to take care of the cases we have here in Nashville" — assuming there aren't many new cases.
